


LEGEND FOR TOWNSHIP MAPS



ANALYSIS OF A SECTION OF LAND





A rod is 164 feet.

A chain is 66 feet, or 4 rods, and contains 100 links, each 7.92 inches in length.

A mile is 320 rods, 80 chains, or 5280 feet.

A square rod is 272% square feet.

An acre contains 43,560 square feet, or 160 square rods.

An acre is 8 rods wide by 20 rods long, or any two numbers of rods whose product is 160.

A township is 36 sections, each a mile square.

The sections in a township are all numbered, beginning in the northeast corner.
