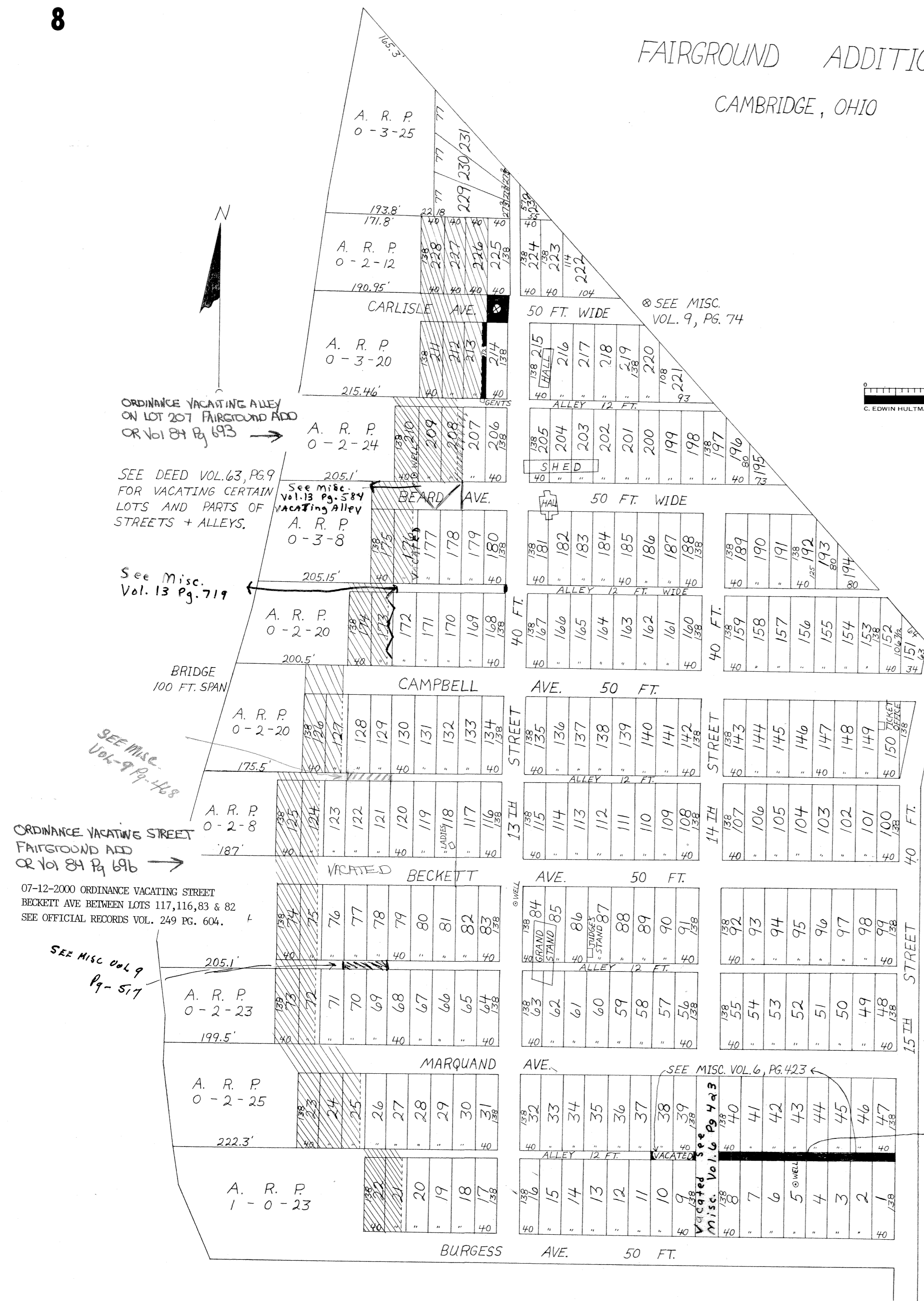

THE ABOVE IS HEREBY CERTIFIED TO BE A CORRECT PLAT OF THE FAIR GROUND ADDITION TO THE VILLAGE OF CAMBRIDGE, OHIO AS SURVEYED NOV. 8th, 1894. THE SAID ADDITION BEING A PART OF A TRACT OF LAND KNOWN AS THE CAMBRIDGE FAIR GROUNDS AND CONVEYED BY DEED OF JOHN MARQUAND ET AL TO SAMUEL M. BURGESS SAID DEED DATED OCTOBER 6th, 1894 AND RECORDED IN VOL. 49 ON PAGE 3 OF THE RECORDS OF DEEDS OF GUERNSEY COUNTY, OHIO. THE SAID PREMISES BEING A PART OF SECTION TWENTY (20) TOWNSHIP TWO (2) AND RANGE THREE (3) AND CONTAINING THIRTY EIGHT ACRES OF LAND MORE OR LESS.
