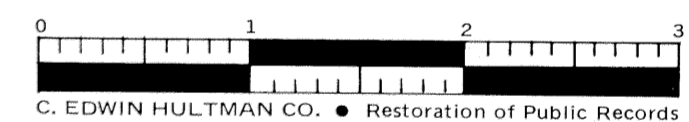
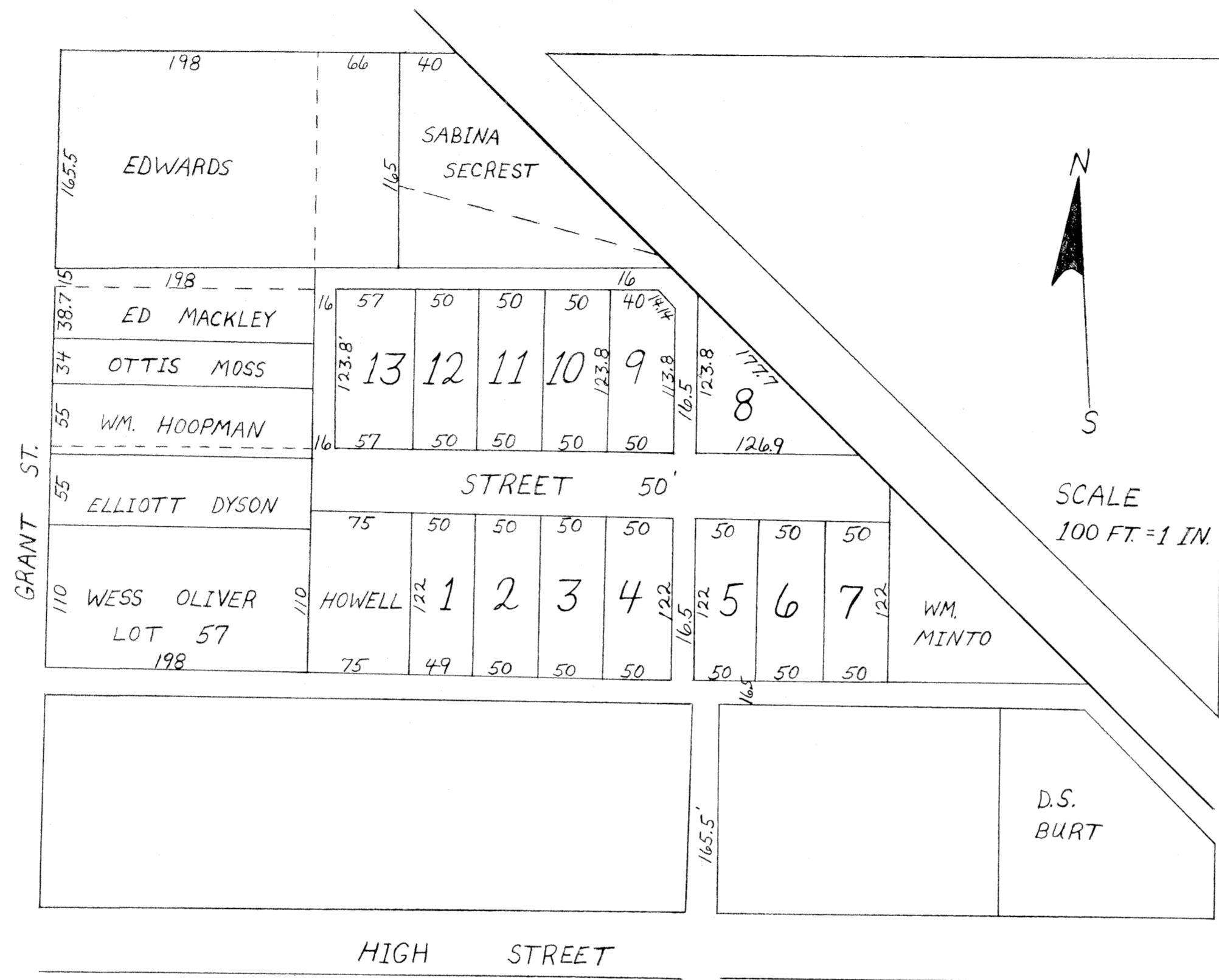


POWER'S ADDITION TO BYESVILLE, OHIO



PLAT OF POWER'S ADDITION TO BYESVILLE, O.

AT THE REQUEST AND BY THE DIRECTIONS OF ANDREWS POWERS I LAID OUT THE FOLLOWING PIECE OF LAND TO WIT. BEING KNOWN AND BEING A PART OF OUT LOT NUMBER FOUR (4) IN WATSON'S ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF BYESVILLE, COMMENCING FOR THE SAME AT THE SOUTH WEST CORNER OF LOT FIFTY SEVEN (57) IN GRANT'S ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF BYESVILLE, THENCE SOUTH 84 DEGREES AND 34 MINUTES EAST 272.2 FT. TO THE SOUTH WEST COR. OF DESCRIBED LAND THENCE WITH SAME LINE 365.5 FT. TO A FENCE THENCE NORTH 5 DEGREES AND 22 MIN. EAST 150.4 FT. TO THE SOUTH WEST SIDE OF C. & M. RAIL WAYS RIGHT OF WAY THENCE N.40°DEG. 37 MIN. WEST ALONG THE SAID RIGHT OF WAY 248.2 FT. TO A STAKE THENCE N.75 DEG. 33 MIN. WEST 208.4 FT. TO THE EAST SIDE OF EDWARDS LOT THENCE SOUTH 1°DEG. 56 MIN. W.36.5 FT. THENCE N.86°DEG. 32 MIN. W.65.5 FT. TO A FENCE THENCE S.5 DEG. 26 MIN. WEST 163.4 FT. THENCE S.83°DEG. 2 MIN. E.76 FT. THENCE SOUTH 4°DEG. 34' MIN. W.148 FT. TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING CONTAINING 2.73 ACRES MORE OR LESS. I LAID OUT SAID PIECE OF LAND IN LOTS STREETS AND ALLEYS AS SHOWN AND DELINEATED ON THE ACCOMPANYING PLAT THE DISTANCES ARE GIVEN IN FEET AND DECIMALS AND ARE MARKED ON OR NEAR THE LINES OR SPACE TO WHICH THEY REFER THE NUMBER OF EACH LOT IS ON THE LOT TO WHICH IT BELONGS. I HEREBY CERTIFY THAT THE ACCOMPANYING PLAT TO BE A TRUE REPRESENTATION OF SAID SURVEY.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT WE A.J. POWER AND MAYME POWERS OWNERS OF THE LAND DELINEATED ON THE ABOVE PLAT, DO HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE THE MAKING OF THE SAME TO BE OUR FREE ACT AND DEED AND WE DO HEREBY DEDICATE THE STREETS AND ALLEYS AS SHOWN THEREON TO THE PUBLIC USE FOREVER. IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF WE SET OUR HANDS THE 10th DAY OF AUG. 1906.
