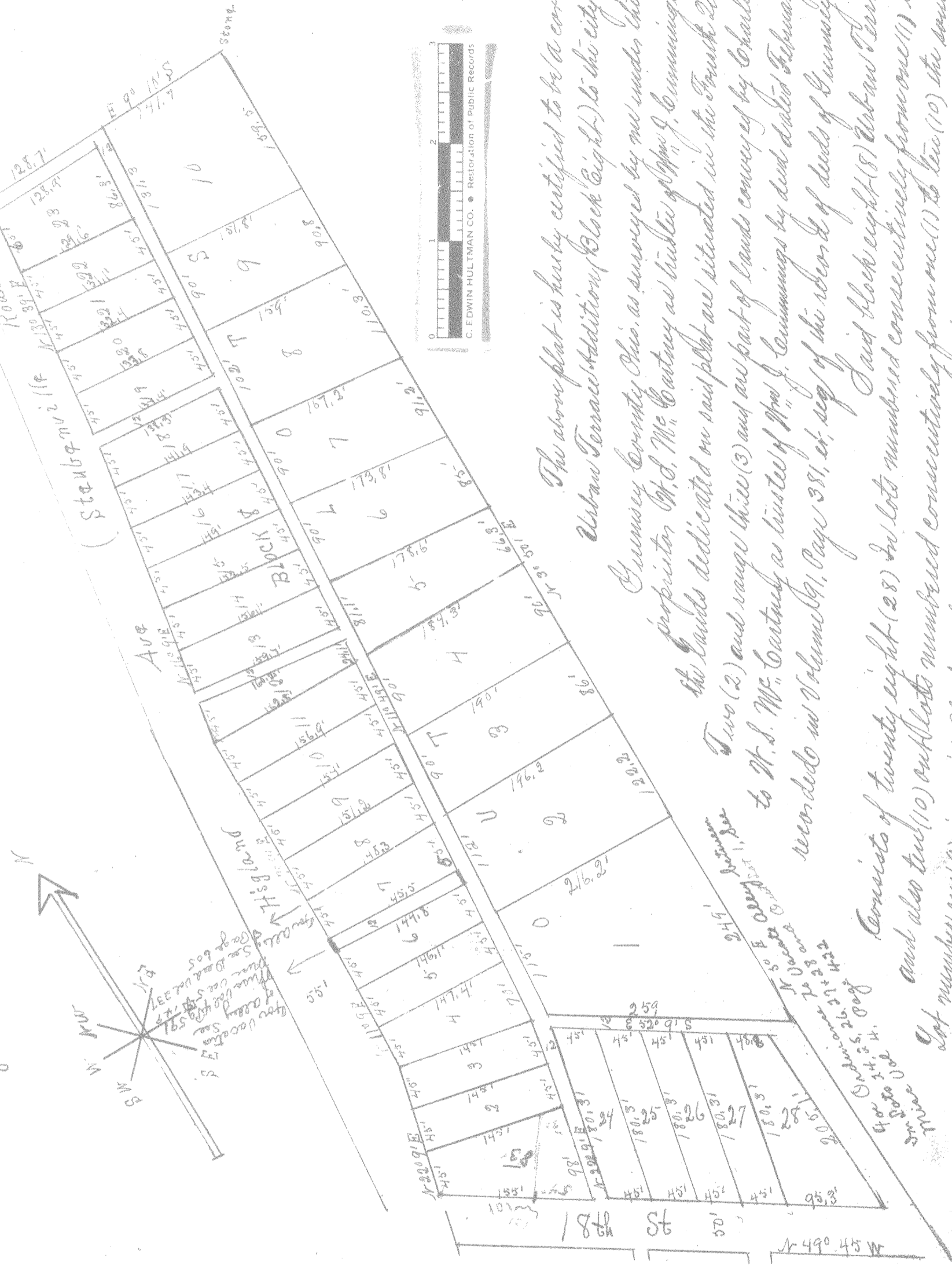


URBAN TERRACE

The above plat is hereby certified to be a correct plat of Urban Terrace Addition, Block Eight, to the city of Cambridge, Cummey County, Ohio, as surveyed by me under the direction of the Corporation of W. S. McCortney as trustee of Mrs. J. Cummings in May, 1910. The lands dedicated in said plat are situated in the Trust Estate of Township Two (2) and range three (3) and are part of lands conveyed by Charles L. Brown et al. to W. S. McCortney as trustee of Mrs. J. Cummings by deed dated February 5th 1907 and recorded in Volume 69, Page 381, of sep. of the records of Cummey County, Ohio.

Said block eight (8) Urban Terrace Addition consists of twenty eight (28) lots numbered consecutively from one (1) to twenty eight (28) and also ten (10) sublots numbered consecutively from one (1) to ten (10) the south west corner of lot number one (1) in said block eight (8) is located at a point in the eastern line of Highland Avenue or Stuyvesant road where it intersects the westerly line of eighteenth (18) street which point is north twenty nine degrees east (N 29 E) measured along the eastern line of said Highland Avenue fifty three and three tenths feet (53.3) from the north west corner of lot number six (6) in Block number seven (7) Urban Terrace Addition as said lot number (6) is marked and delineated on the recorded plat showing in plat book nos. Pages 27, and 28, 4, B. Brown, C. C.

Know all men by these presents that W. S. McCortney as trustee of Mrs. J. Cummings proprietor of the lands delineated on the above plat Urban Terrace Addition Block eight (8) do hereby acknowledge the making of the same to be my free act and deed as such trustee and I do hereby dedicate the streets, roads and alleys as shown through to public use, as such, forever.
