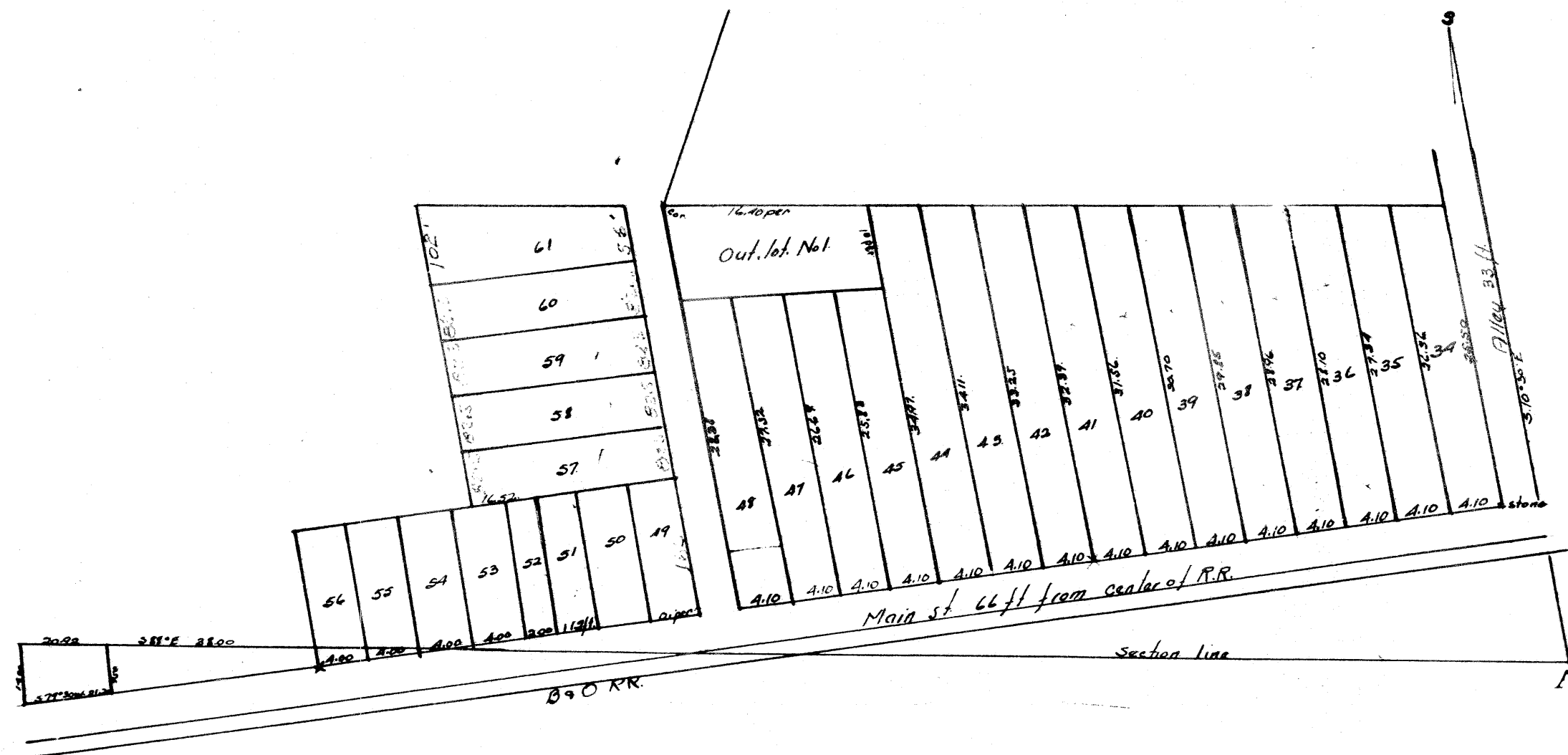


ROBINS 1ST. ADD. TO GUERNSEY.
