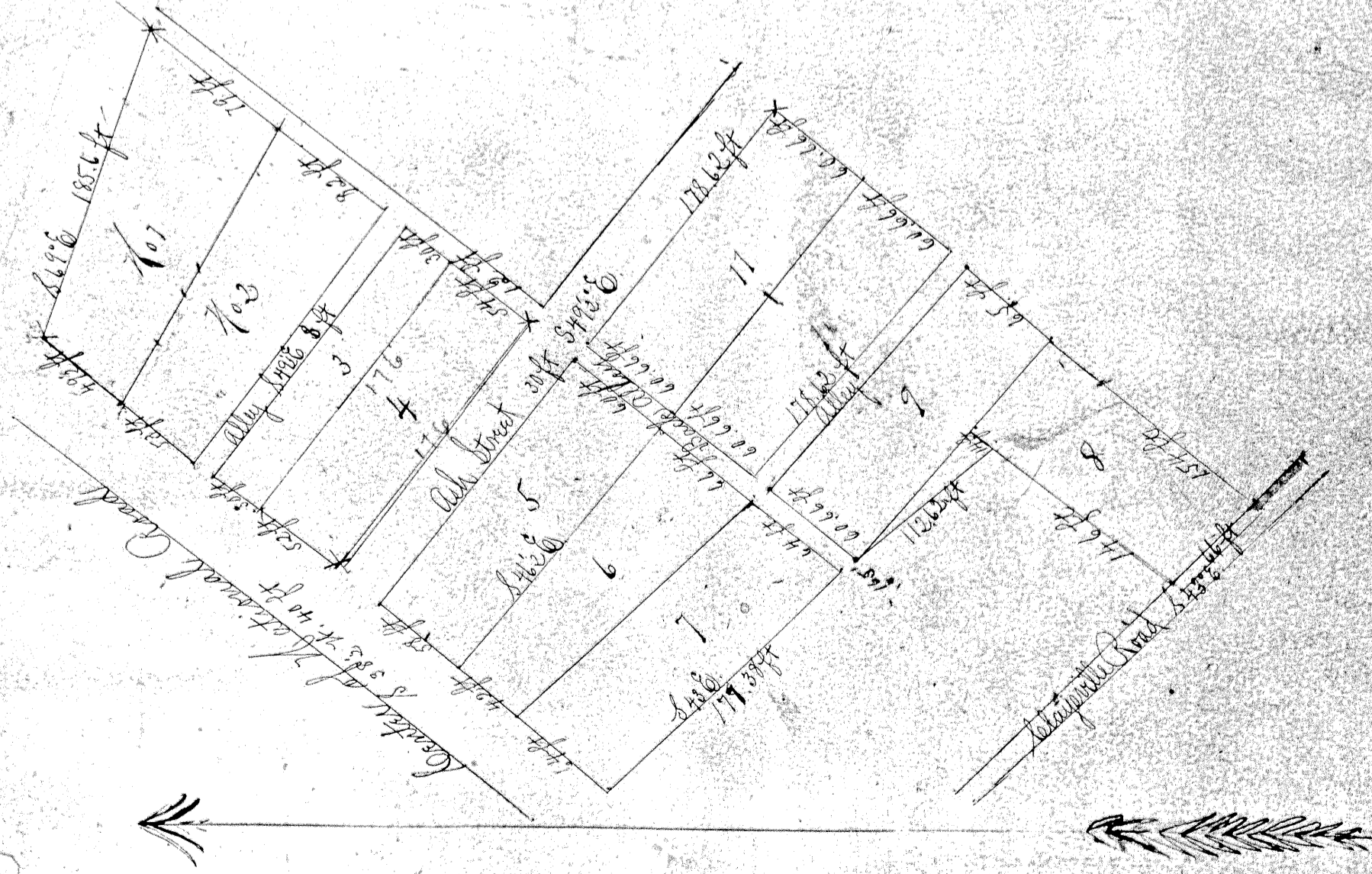


Lots Addition to West Cambridge



Scale 20 ft to an inch. Stones planted at ground marked true & surveyed Oct 30th 1856 for Jonathan Neets the above addition to West Cambridge laid south of the National Road and the West Cambridge road of Lot No. 1 laid from the southwest partment of the bridge to 31 1/2 feet 9.55 rods Road and back Alley Lane 8.55 feet. Also street bears S 47 1/2 E whose number of lots shown.

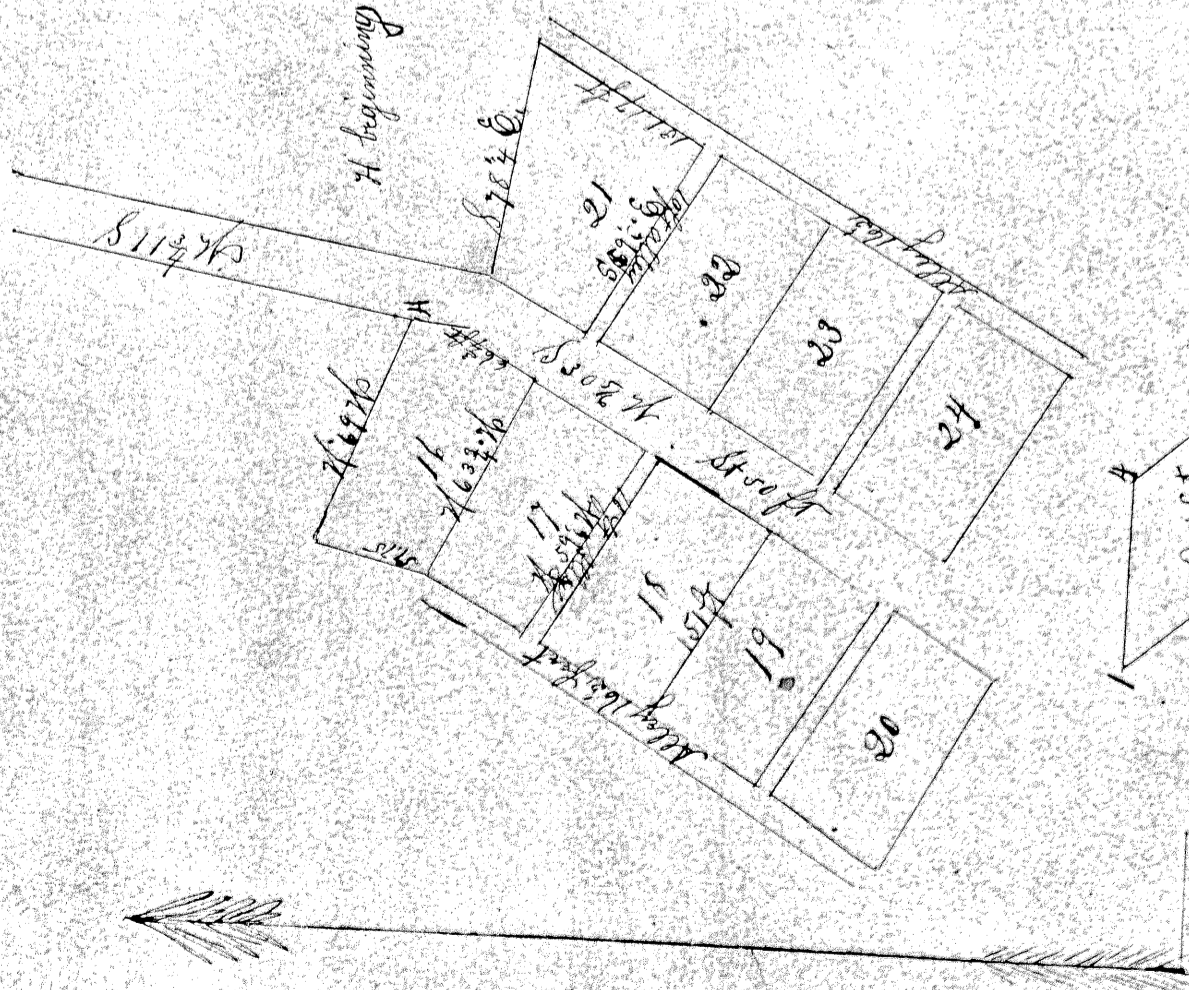
