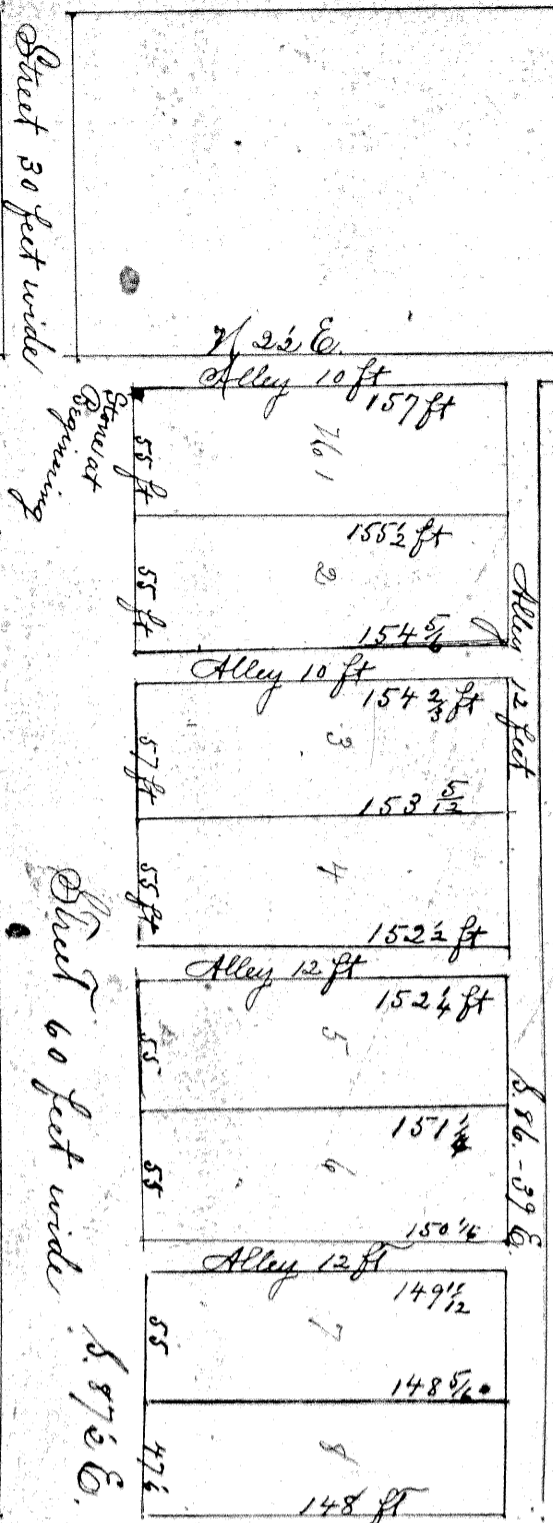


Plan of Land Addition to West Cambridge



May 31st 1888

Surveyed for the above Addition to West Cambridge Commission 30 feet north of a stake in the center of the eastern of adjacent ground in General Addition to Cambridge Land stake bands 817 1/2 & 112 feet from the north East corner of lot No 15 in Range Addition to Cambridge. (See width of Lots No 1, 2, 4, 5, 6 & 7 are all 57 feet in front lot No 8 is 47 1/2 feet in width lot No 3 is 57 feet the lots all vary in length as is shown in the above plat the lots all run back 72 1/2 feet and width 87 1/2 & 55 ft except No 8 is 47 1/2 and No 5 is 57 feet the north side of lots runs 881 - 876 feet square
