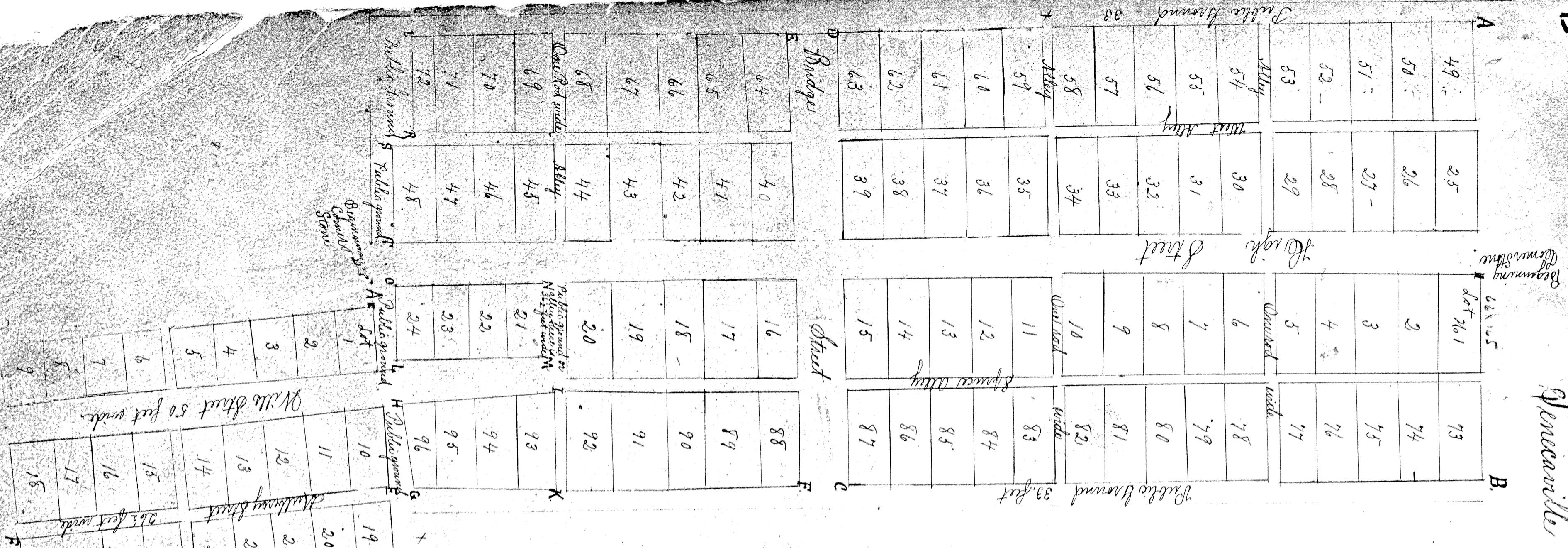

 Shager and Stuart, Esqrs Examined, Variants, Judges of the Court of Common Pleas

 Court are the legal and true owners and possessors of the land hereinafter described and plat
 by the Matter of the Petition of Otto Habing and others to vacate
 the original plat of the town of Seneca and of the addition
 thereto and to allow the plat to stand from and to be established
 and to give as the plat of said town
 the one of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
 forty one, caused the Petitioner, by Joseph Degehardt Esquire, their Attorney and legal
 agent, to file of the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas within and for the County
 of Hubbard and the State of Ohio the following petition to wit, Do the Honorable
 the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas of the County of Seneca, the Petition
 of the undersigned Citizens of the Town of Seneca, in said County of Hubbard, respectfully
 represent that an arrangement of a certain unincorporated town and certain part of
 said town has unconstitutionally and illegally been made and erected, in
 manner not to agree with said plat and for the purpose, according to the provisions
 as therein contained, to make an arrangement of said arrangement of an arrangement
 not entered into by said Citizens that said town should be annexed and included
 by the County thereof, which was an arrangement with said arrangement caused into
 effect (all of which said arrangement and plat are hereby attached) by the Petitioner
 (who are) Citizens and residents and owners of said town and
 portions of the same of the following name, do hereby most earnestly request
 that the Original plat of the said addition be vacated and that they
