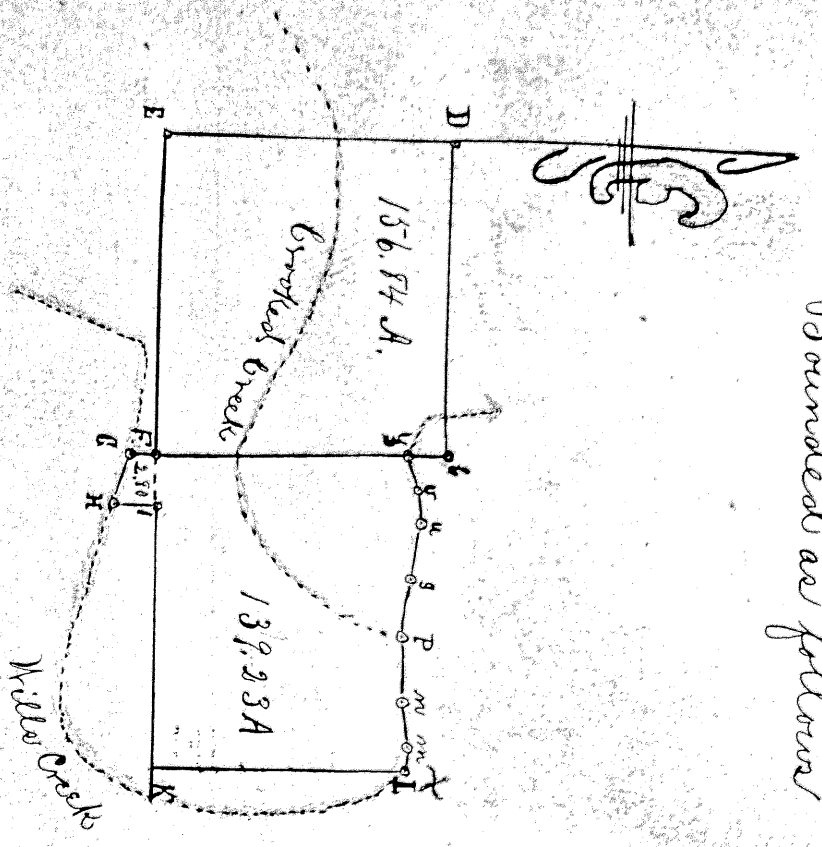


Plot of a tract of land belonging to Mr Samuel Morrison of Cambridge, Sep. 9. 0.

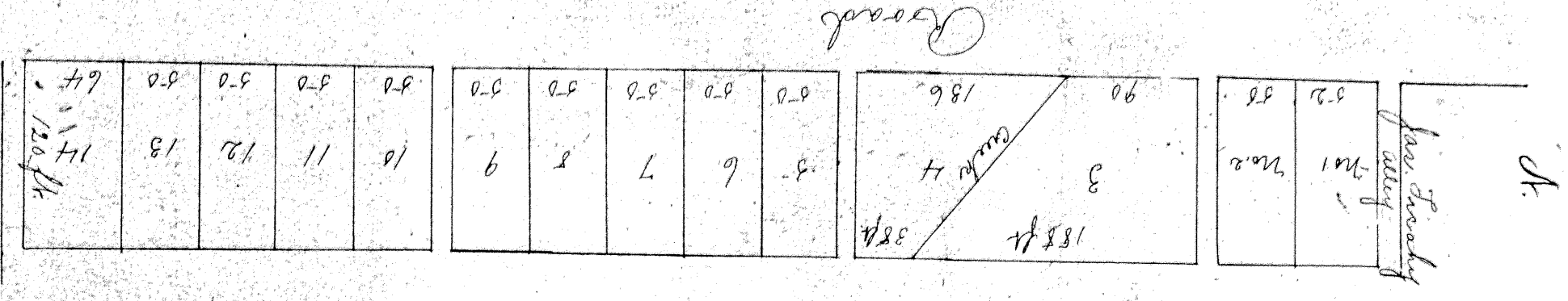

The following is a description of a tract of land, situated in the township of Millersburg, county of Sumner, to State of Ohio being a part of the north west quarter of the north west quarter of section seven township nine Range, seven and land set as an addition to the village of Spencer Station. Said tract situated on the East side of the highway and composed of front lots 120 ft deep, facing or fronting the highway, and five alleys 10 ft wide extending east from the front of lot in the middle of the road, 120 ft to the back of lots adjoining said alley. Beginning at the north end of plot, the lots are numbered consecutively from the (1) front inclusive to the south. Alleys are located as follows, first alley between No. (1) one and a lot owned by Joe. Steady second alley is between lot No. 2 and 3 third alley is between No. 4 and 5 fourth alley is between No. 6 and 10 fifth alley between No. 14 and land owned by H. P. Broomhall. The front of each lot running No. 1 and 8, ends with lot rectangular in form excepting No. 3 and 4 185 ft. a creek running between 5 and 7 all the lots facing 50 ft creek No. (1) one and No. 14 No. 1 facing 52 ft No. 14 facing 64 ft No. 2 owned by M. E. Edmund.
