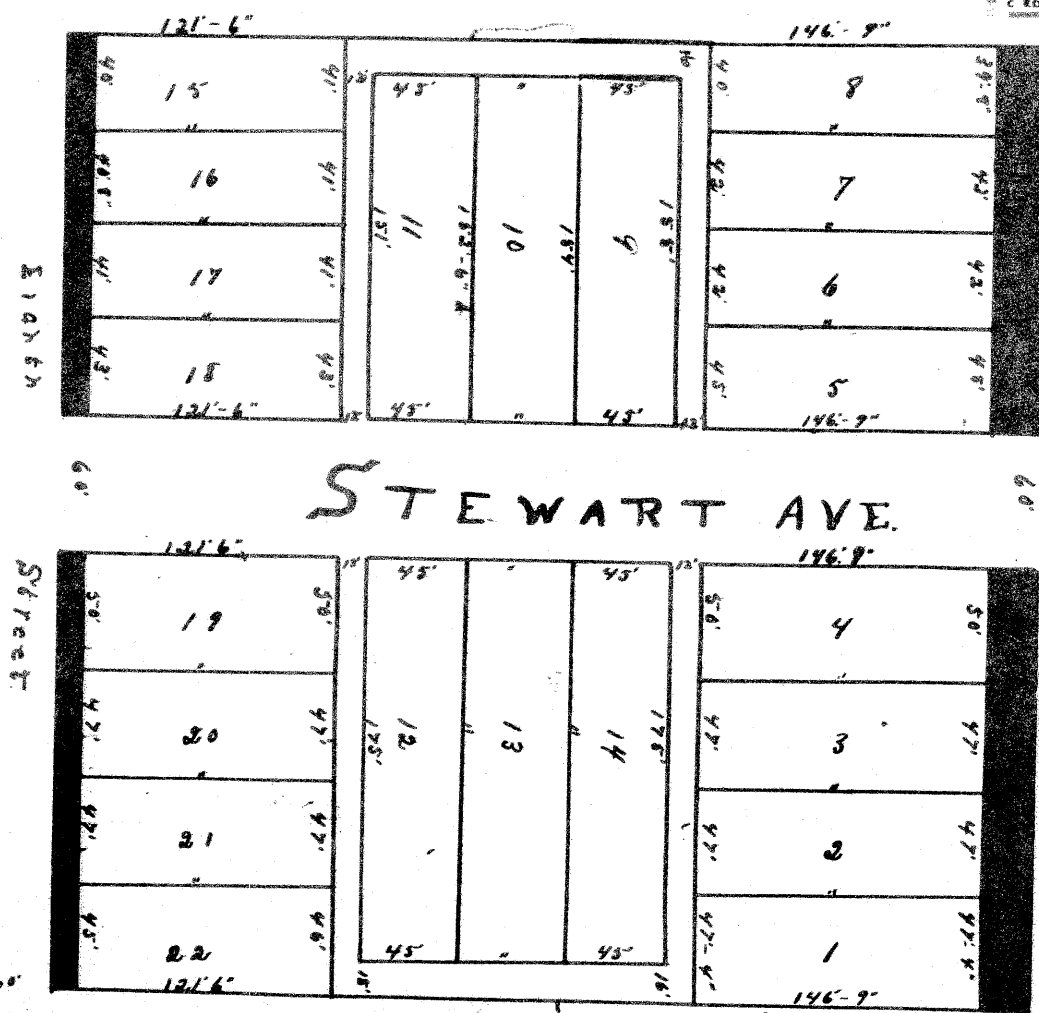
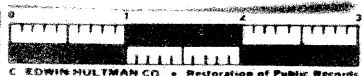


THE NANCY BROWN ADDITION CAMBRIDGE OHIO
