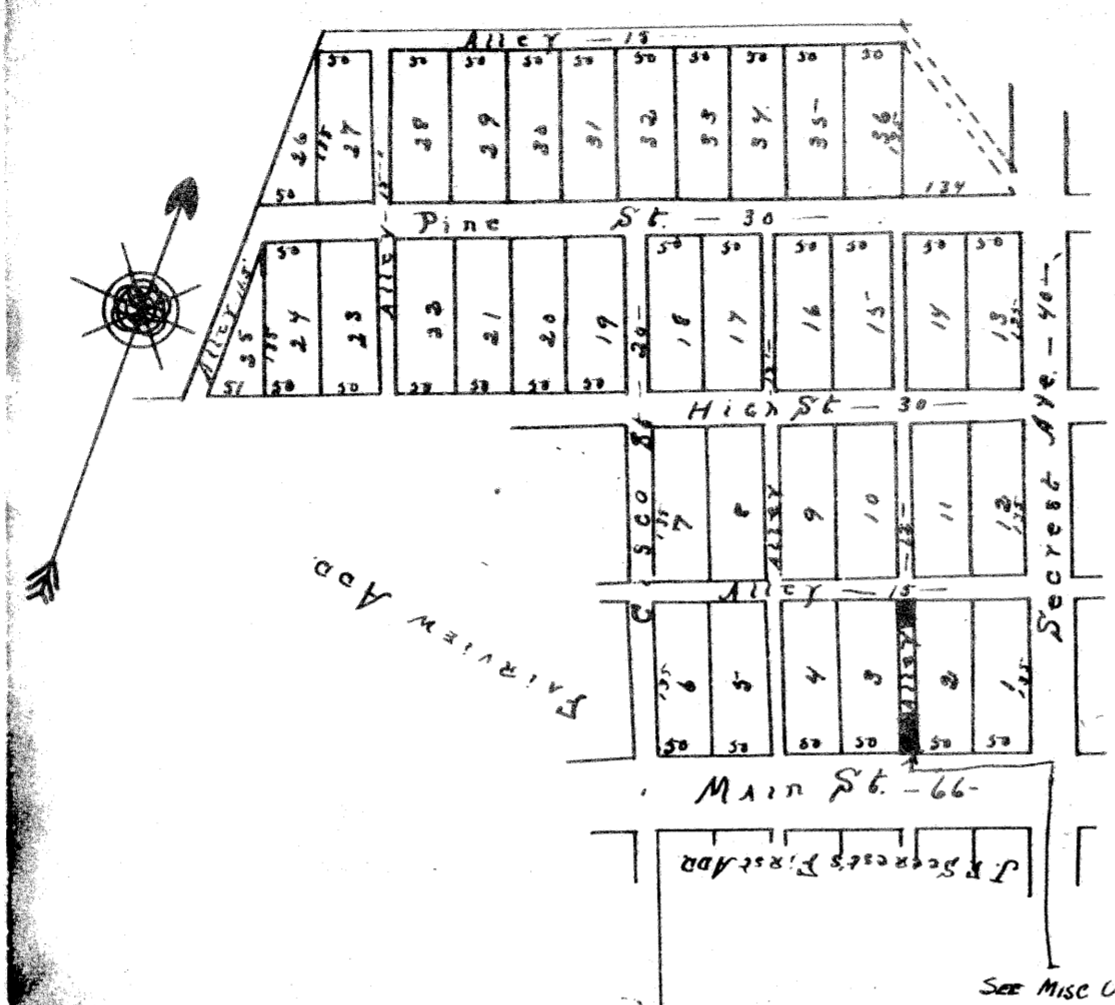
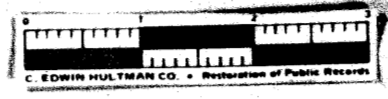

 Plat of Jacob F. Seecrest's Second Addition to Pleasant City, Huron County, Ohio.



Description
 The above addition is situated in the north half of the south west quarter of section eight (8) Township eight (8) Range nine (9), and bounded & described as follows: Commencing at the north east corner of Jacob F. Seecrest's first addition to Pleasant City, thence North 75° 20' East three hundred and sixty four (364) feet, thence North 17° West five hundred and forty six (546) feet, thence South 75° 20' West five hundred and thirty four (534) feet, thence North 17° West one hundred and fifty (150) feet, thence South 75° 20' West five hundred and ten (510) feet, thence South three hundred and thirty five (335) feet, thence North 75° 20' East three hundred and ninety seven (397) feet, thence South 17° East three hundred and eighty one (381) feet to place of beginning, and consists in the subdivision of the same into lots as shown in the annexed plat. The linear division of the lots the width of the streets and alleys appear on the plat in the denomination of feet and decimals thereof.
