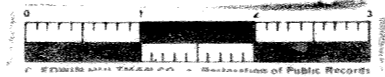
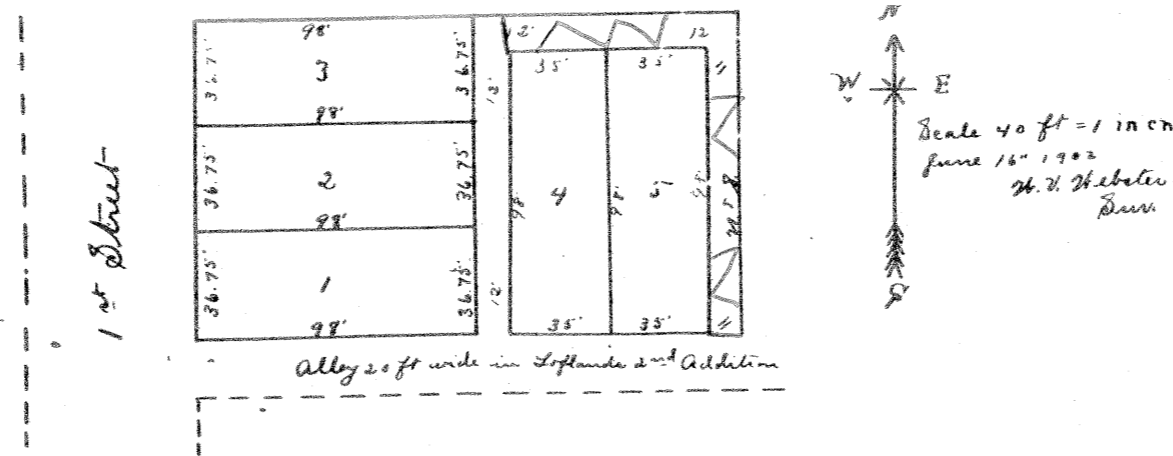


Walah addition to Cambridge, O. Sub-division of the South-West portion of
