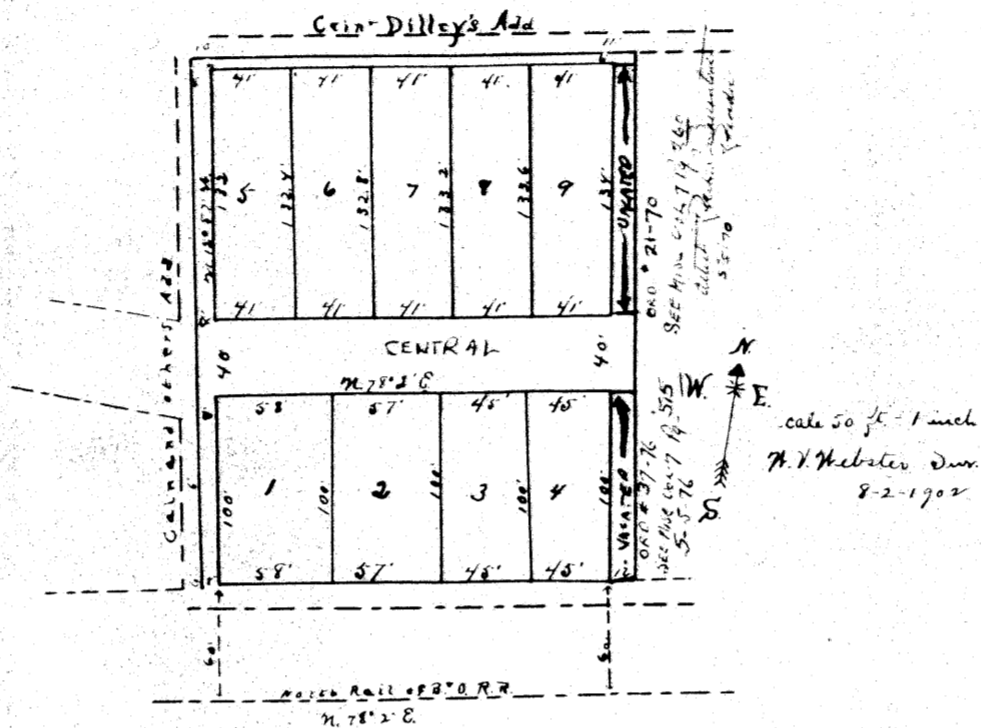


# CYRUS B. TURNBAUGH'S ADDITION TO EAST CAMBRIDGE
