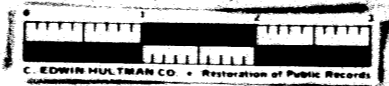


THE BYESVILLE IMPROVE

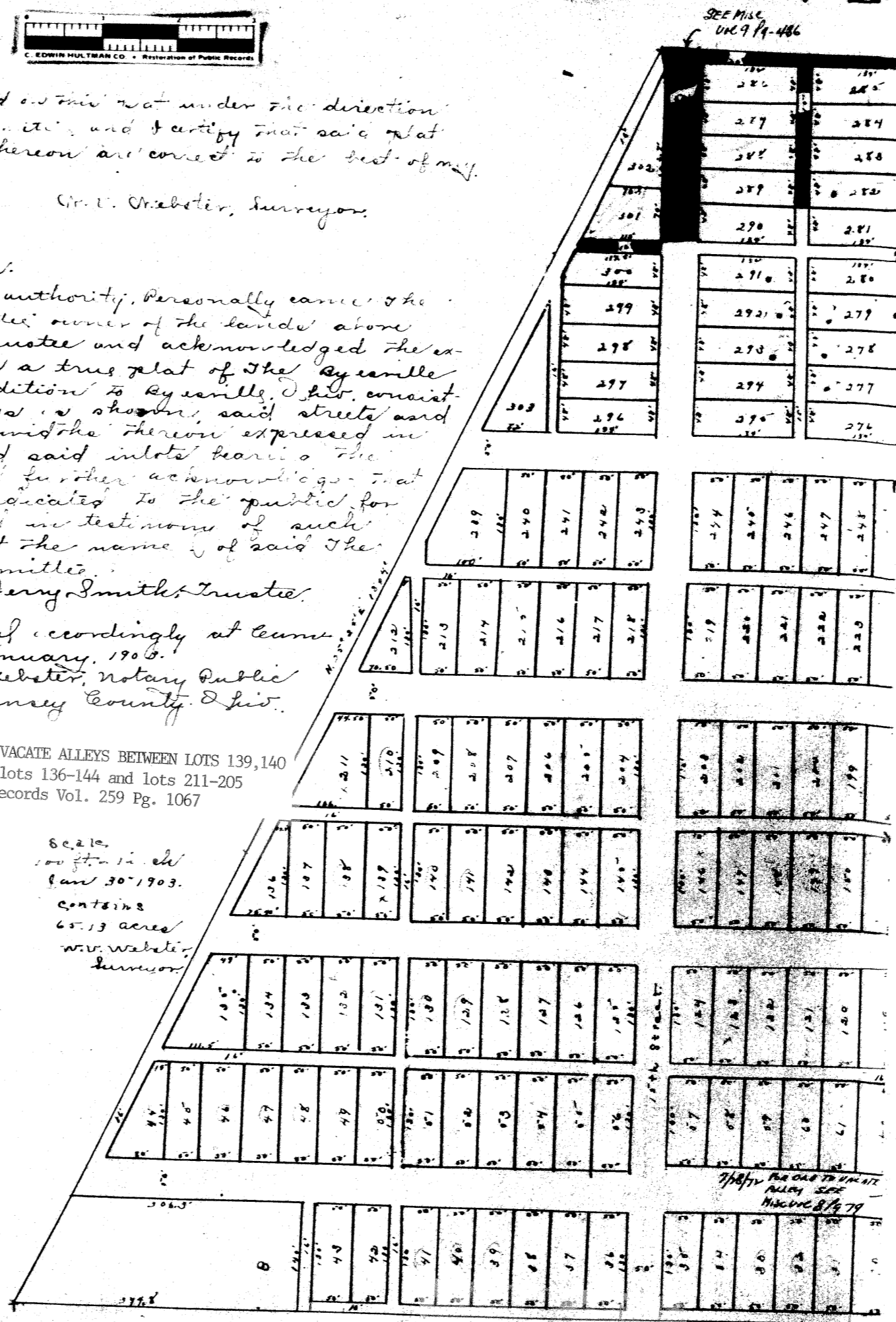
