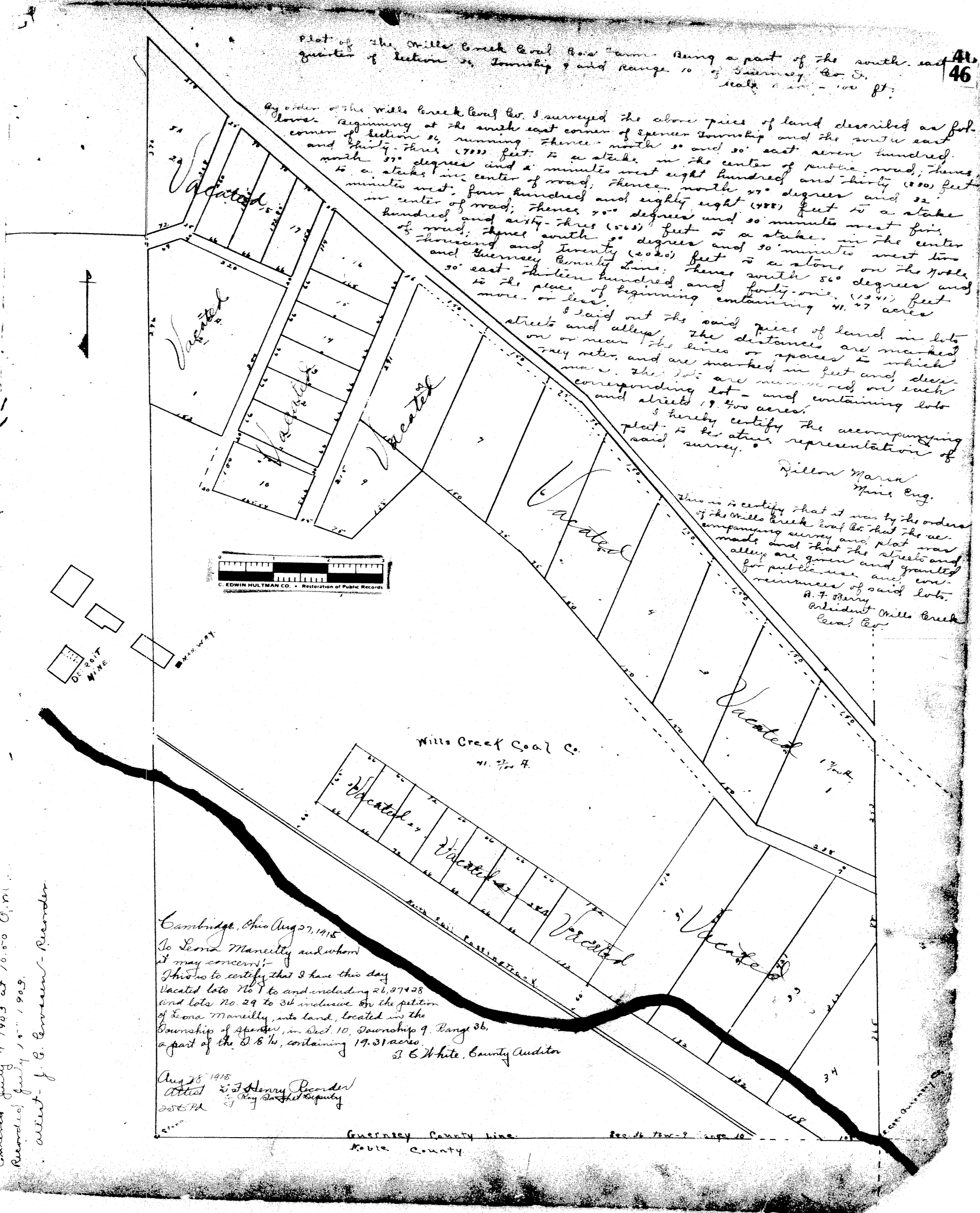


Plot of the Mills Creek Coal Co. farm being a part of the south east quarter of Section 24 Township 9 and Range 10 of Sherman Co. D.

By order of the Mills Creek Coal Co. I surveyed the above piece of land described as follows beginning at the south east corner of Spencer Township and the south east corner of Section 24 running thence north 50° and 30' east seven hundred and thirty-three (733) feet to a stake in the center of public road; thence north 50° degrees and 20 minutes west eight hundred and thirty (830) feet to a stake in center of road; thence north 50° degrees and 30' minutes west four hundred and eighty eight (488) feet to a stake in center of road; thence 70° degrees and 30' minutes west five hundred and sixty-three (563) feet to a stake in the center of road; thence south 50° degrees and 30' minutes west two thousand and twenty (2020) feet to a stone on the north and thence east thirty-one (31) feet to a stake on the north; thence south 50° degrees and 30' minutes west to the place of beginning and forty-one (41) feet more or less.

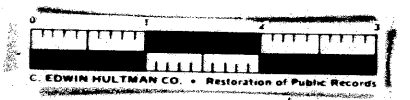
