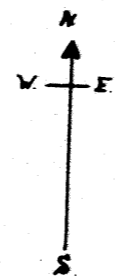
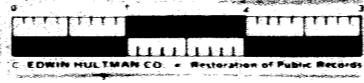


H. H. MEEK'S 2ND ADDITION
