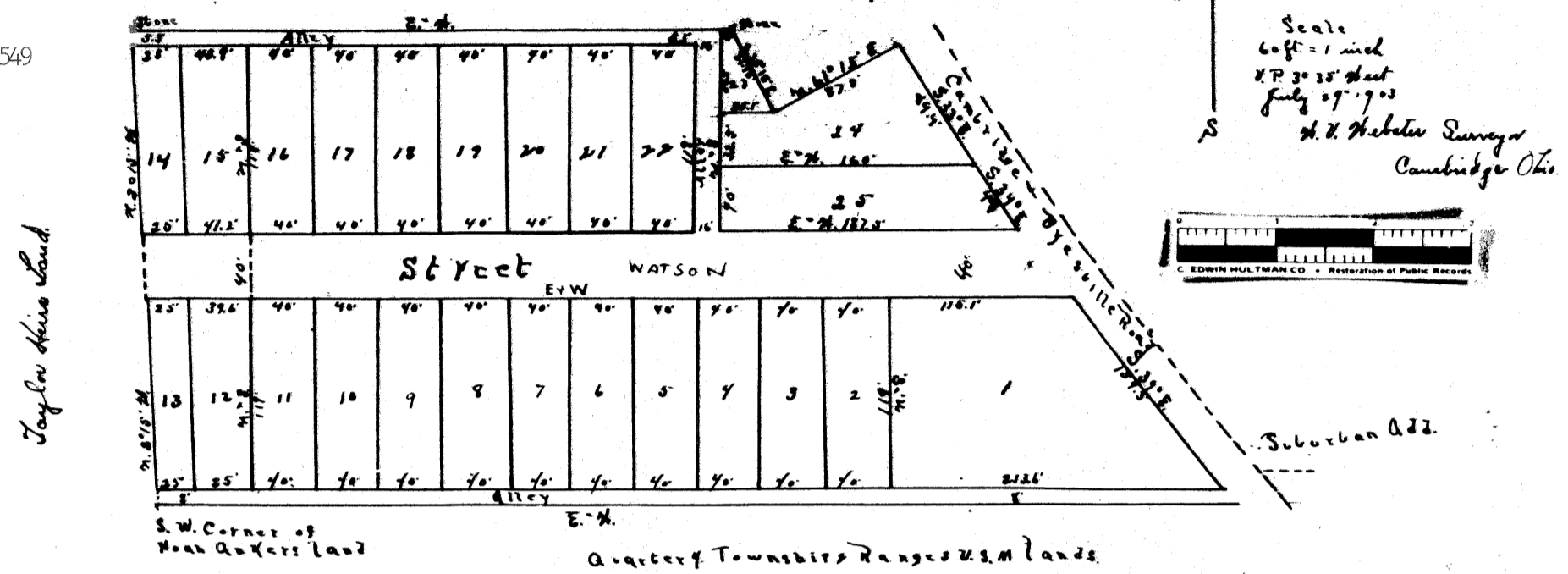


# NOAH ANKER'S ADDITION TO EAST CAMBRIDGE, OHIO.
