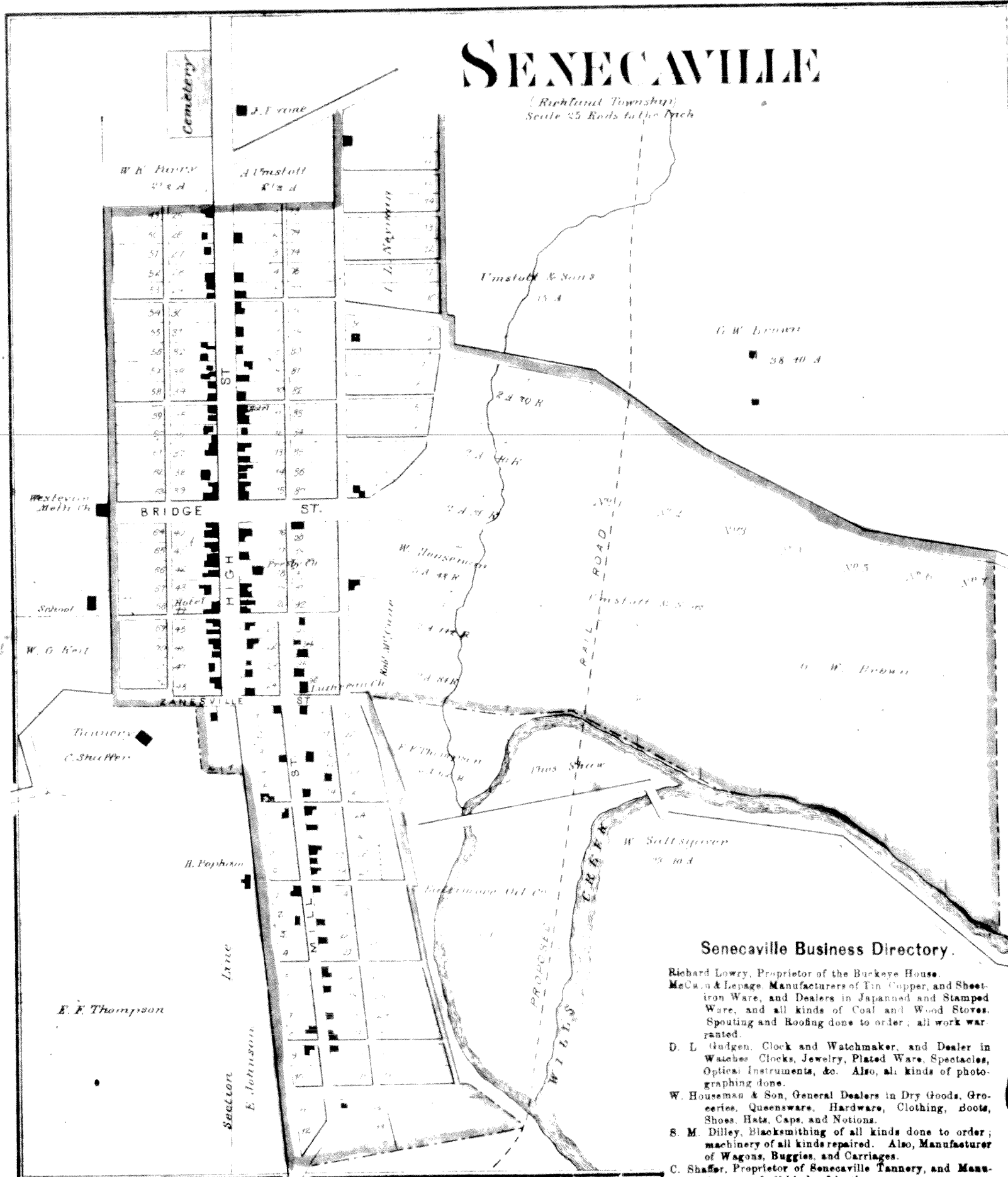

Scale 25 Rods to the Inch

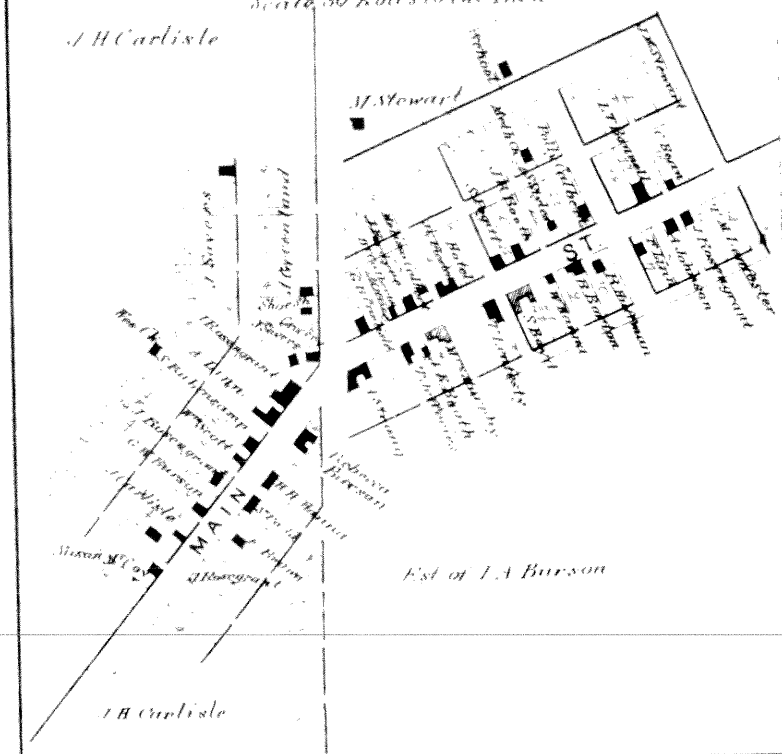
