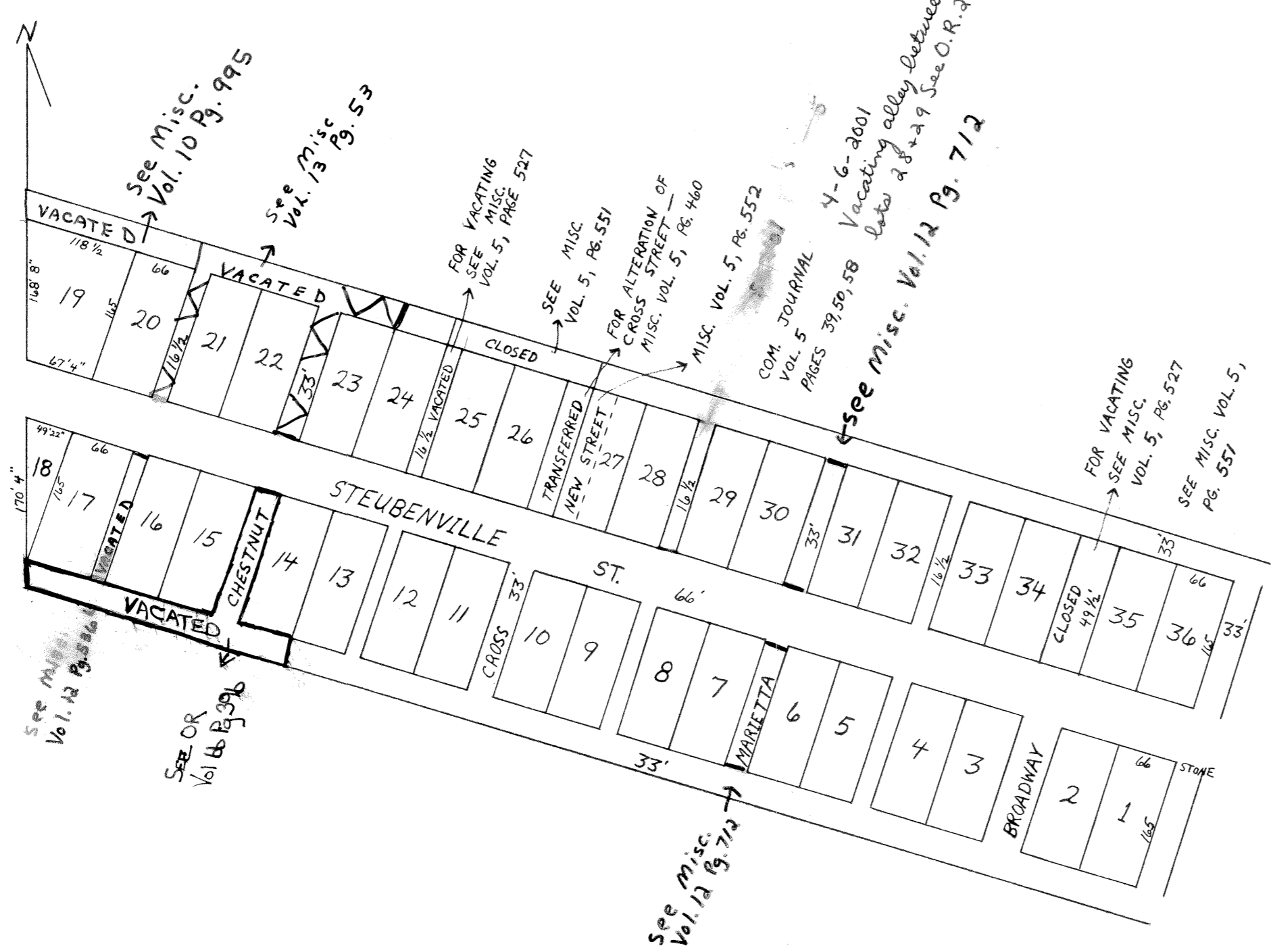


PLAT OF CENTERVILLE

LOT NO. 19 CONTAINS 55 RODS, LOT NO. 18 CONTAINS 15 RODS. THERE IS A BORDER ON THE NORTH & SOUTH & EAST OF SAID TOWN ALLOWED BY THE PROPRIETOR FOR PUBLIC USE. THE STREETS & ALLEYS CONTAIN 6 ACRES & 31 RODS. LOTS CONTAIN 8 ACRES & 110 RODS. STONE PLACED FOR COMENCMENT AT THE N.E. COR. LOT NO. 1 MARKED 1.

PLAT & DESCRIPTION OF THE TOWN OF CENTERVILLE IN GUE. CO. OHIO LAID OUT ON THE S.W. QUARTER OF SEC. 5, TWP. 2, & R.2 IN THE MILITARY DISTRICT OF LAND SUBJECT TO BE SOLD AT ZANESVILLE, OHIO. STEUBENVILLE ST. BEARS N. 73°W. BY S. 73°E. 66 FT. WIDE. ALL THE OTHER STREETS & ALLEYS CROSS AT RIGHT ANGLES. THE ALLEYS ARE ALL 16½ FT. WIDE, BROADWAY IS 14½ FT. WIDE. ALL THE OTHER STREETS ARE 33 FT. WIDE, ALL THE LOTS EXCEPT 18 & 19 FRONT ON STEUBENVILLE ST. 66 FT. & RUN BACK 165 FT. & CONTAIN ¼ ACRE. LOT NO. 18 FRONTS ON STEUBENVILLE ST. 49 FT. & 22 INCHES, THE EAST SIDE OF SAID LOT RUNS PARALLELL TO LOT NO. 17 & RUNS BACK 10 RODS OR 165 FT. THENCE DUE NORTH, 170 FT. & 4 INCHES, LOT NO. 19 FRONTS 67'4" ON STEUBENVILLE ST. THE EAST SIDE OF STEUBENVILLE ST. RUNS PARALLELL TO LOT NO. 20, THENCE N. 73°W. 118½ FT. 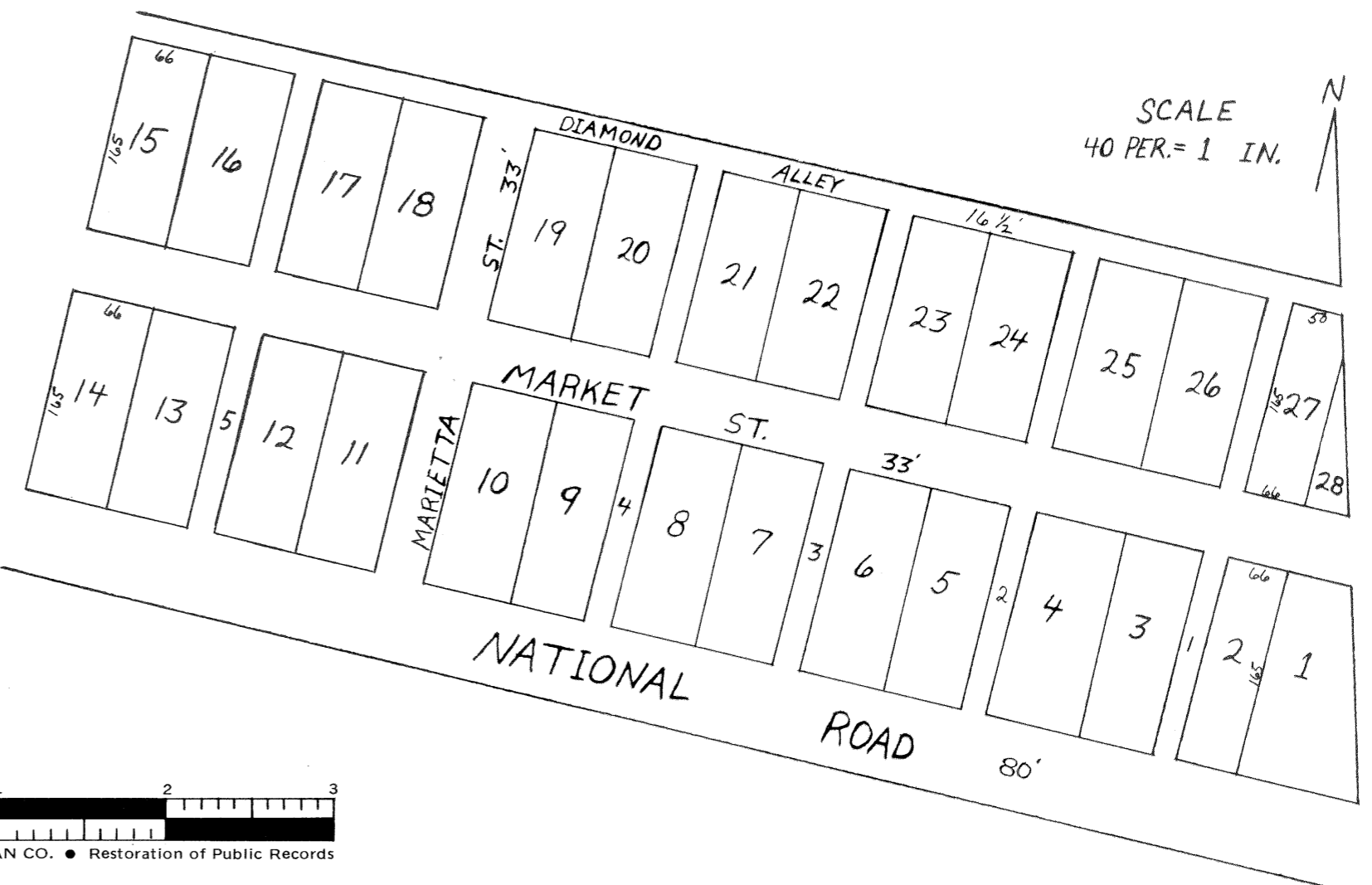

PLAT & DESCRIPTION OF THE TOWN OF EASTON SITUATED IN GUE. CO. OHIO AND ADJOINING THE EAST END OF THE TOWN OF WASHINGTON IN GUE. CO. BEGINING FOR THE SAME AT A STONE AT THE N.W. COR. OF LOT NO. 1 IN THE SAID TOWN OF EASTON, THENCE SOUTH 10 PERCHES TO THE NATIONAL ROAD, THENCE WITH SAID ROAD N. 74°W. WHICH IS THE BEARING OF SAID TOWN (N. 74°W.) BY (S. 74°E.). ALL THE LOTS EXCEPT NO'S 1-27-28 CONTAIN ¼ ACRE BEING 66 FT. IN FRONT & RUNS BACK 165 FT. LOT NO. 1 FRONTS 66 FT. BACKS 33 FT. & THEN RUNS BACK 165 FT. & BEING A FRACTION CONTAINS 30 RODS, LOT NO. 27 FRONTS 66 FT. & THE BACK PART OF SAID LOT IS 50 FT. RUNS BACK 165 FT. & CONTAINS 35 RODS BEING A FRACTION. LOT NO. 28 FRONTS 1 ROD & RUNS TO A POINT AT A DISTANCE OF 7½ RODS & CONTAINS 3½ RODS. MAIN ST. BEARS N. 74°W. BEING 80 FT. WIDE & MARKET ST. RUNS PARALELL WITH MAIN ST. DIAMOND ALLEY RUNS PARALLELL WITH MAIN ST. BEING 1 ROD WIDE, MARIETTA ST. RUNS AT RIGHT ANGLES WITH MAIN ST. & IS 33 FT. WIDE BEING THE SAME AS MARKET ST. ALL THE ALLEYS RUN AT RIGHT ANGLES WITH MAIN ST. EXCEPT DIAMOND ALLEY. SAID FOUR LOTS, ALLEYS & STREETS CONTAIN 8 ACRES, .70 IN ALL. THE ALLEYS & ST'S CONTAIN 3 ACRES & .85.
