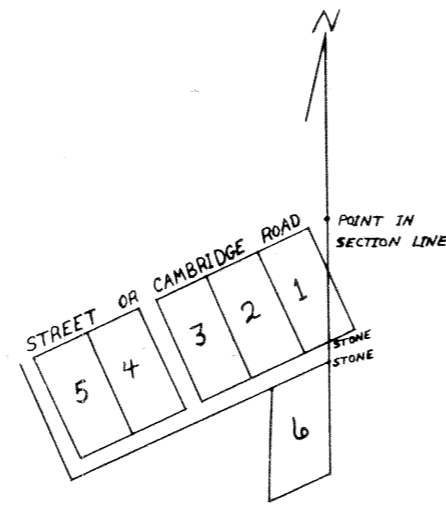

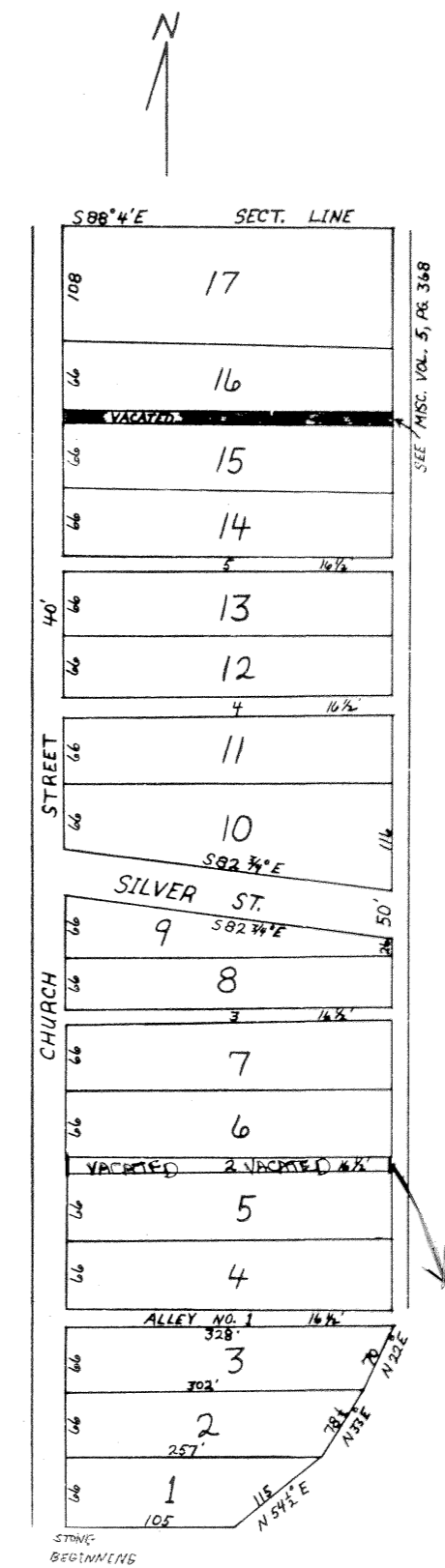


ADDITION TO ANTRIM

THENCE S. 25 1/2 E. 8 PER. THENCE N. 58 1/2 E. 1.92 STONE CORNER THENCE N. 71 E. 208 THENCE N. 24 W. 800 TO THE BEGINNING CONT. 32 SQ. PER. LOTS NO. 2,3,4,5, BEARING IN FRONT S. 64 3/4 W. 4 PER. IN FRONT AT RIGHT ANGLES WITH S. 25 1/2 E. 8 PER. BACK EACH CONTAINING 32 SQ. PER. LOT NO. 6 BEGINNING STONE IN THE SEC. PLAT OF GEO. ROSE ADDITION TO SENECAVILLE IN GUE. CO. OHIO RICHLAND TWP.

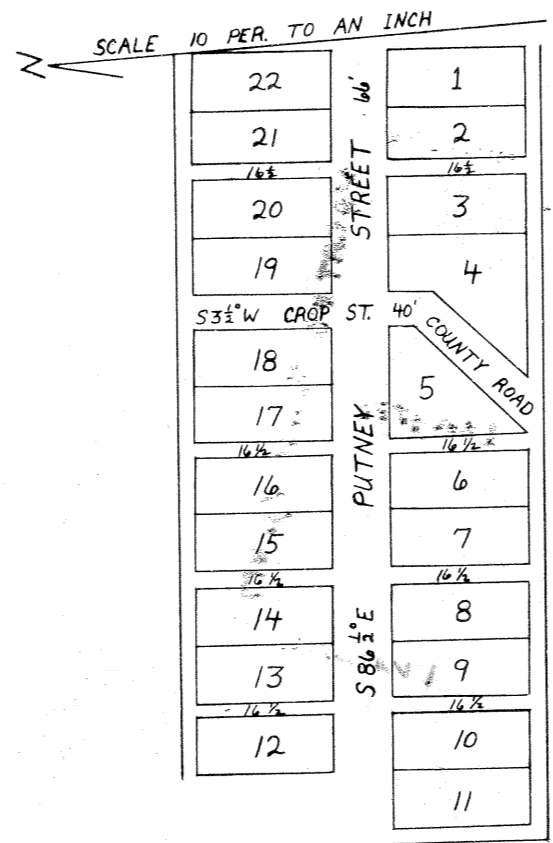

COMMENCING FOR SAID TOWN AT A STONE AT THE N.E. COR. OF LOT NO. 1 BEARING FROM A BLACK OAK 30 IN. IN DIAM. N. 45 1/2 E. 96 LINKS MARKED LETTER A. LOTS NO. 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15,16,17,18,19,20,21,22 N. 3 1/2 E. 10 PER. AT RIGHT ANGLES WITH N. 86 1/2 W. 4 PER. EACH CONTAIN 40 SQ. PERCHES, LOT NO. 4 WITH ITS FRONT & EAST SIDE THE SAME BEARING & DISTANCE AS THE ABOVE LOTS. THE BACK END OF NO. 4 N. 86 1/2 W. 10.42 PER.
