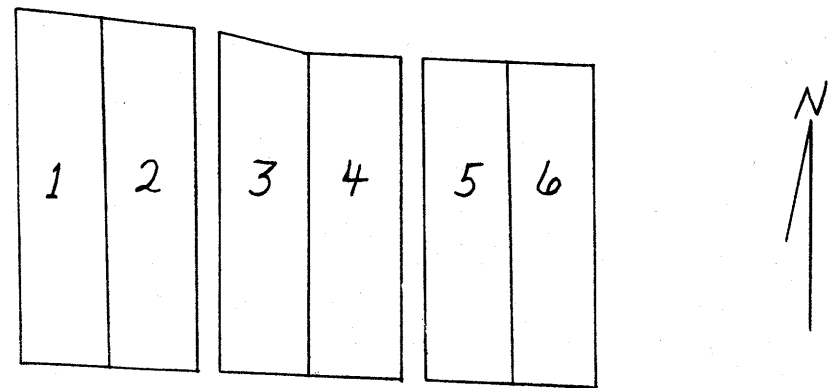


PLAT OF GREENWOOD



PLAT OF THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD

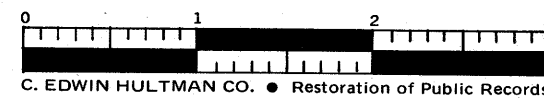
LAYOUT BY MR. THOS. TAYLOR ON THE GRADE LEADING FROM MARIETTA TO WASHINGTON SO. OF SENECA FORKS OF WILLS CREEK, RICHLAND TWP. GUE. CO. OHIO, MAY 25th, 1848 (LAID OUT AT A SCALE OF 8 PER. TO AN INCH). BEGINNING FOR THE SAID TOWN AT A STONE AT THE S.W. COR. OF LOT NO. 1 LOTS NO. 1,2,3,4,5, 6 FRONT WITH THE STREET S.85° E. & ARE ALL 4 PER. IN FRONT EXCEPT LOT NO. 2 WHICH IS 4.68 IN FRONT. THE WEST SIDE OF LOT NO. 1 RUNS N.16 PER THE LINE BETWEEN 1 & 2 IS NORTH 16 PER TO THE CREEK BETWEEN 2 & 3 NORTH 15.48 PER. BETWEEN 5 & 6 N.14.60 PER. TO THE EASTSIDE OF NO. 6 IS NORTH 15.32 PER. ALL THE SAID LOTS RUN TO THE CREEK. LOT NO. 1 AT THE BACK END & BEAR N.86 W. LOT NO. 2 N.87 1/2 W. LOT NO. 3 N.75 W. LOT NO. 4 N.84 W., LOT NO. 5 N.86 1/2 W., LOT NO. 6, S.87 1/2 W. AND ARE EACH 4 PER. IN WIDTH EXCEPT LOT NO. 2 WHICH IS 4.68 PER IN WIDTH. LOT NO. 1 CONTAINS 64 SQ. PER. LOT NO. 2 71.88 SQ. PER. NO. 3 60.48 PER. NO. 4 57.92 SQ. PER. NO. 5 56.80 SQ. PER. NO. 6 59 SQ. PER. ALLEY BETWEEN LOTS NO. 2 & 3 & S. PARALLEL WITH THE LOTS AND IS 1 ROD WIDE. ALLEY NO. 2 BETWEEN LOT NO. 4 & 5 IS PARALLEL WITH THE LOTS & IS 1 ROD WIDE.

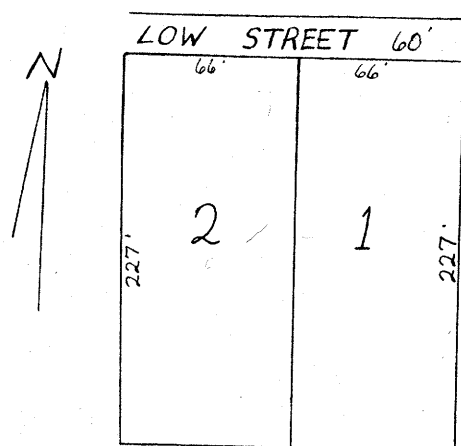

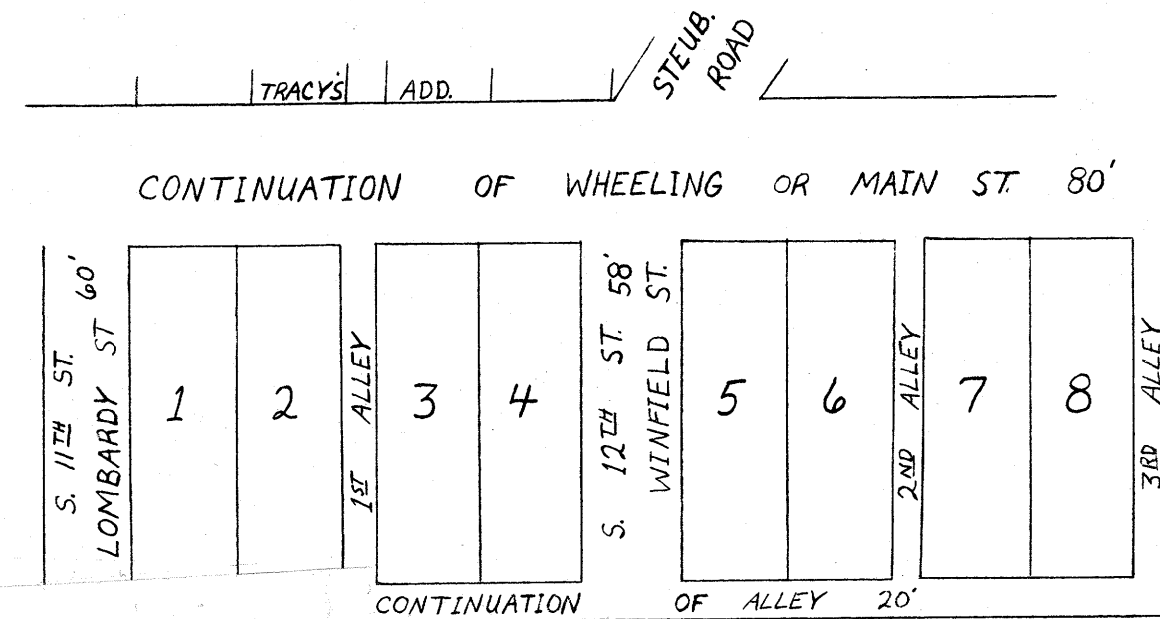

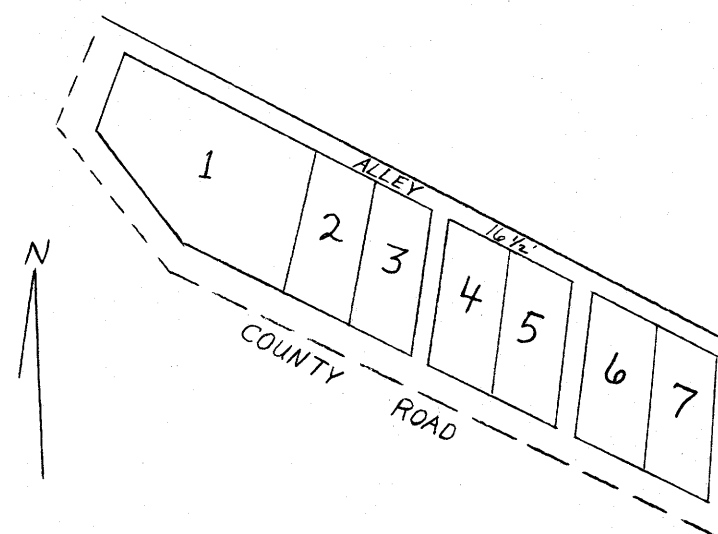

A PLAT OF SURVEY MADE MAY 14th, 1855 IN TWP. 9 R.7 S.1 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PLATING THE TOWN OF BAILEYS MILLS IN THE S.W. COR. OF S.E. QUARTER SEC. 1 38.86 RODS FROM THE CORNER STONE N.1°E. TO STONE MARKED THUS X IN PLAT, THENCE S.24°E. 5 RODS THENCE S.43 1/2°E. 0.60 RODS THENCE S.67°E. 8.64 RODS THENCE S.67° E.8 RODS THENCE LEAVING AN ALLEY 1 ROD WIDE RUNNING AT RIGHT ANGLES ON NO. 23° E. TO BACK OF LOTS S.67° E. AT NO. 4 DESCRIBING 4 & 54 RODS EACH THENCE LEAVING AN ALLEY 1 ROD WIDE TO COR. OF NO. 6 THENCE S.67°E. DESCRIBING 6 & 7 4 RODS ON EACH FRONT.
