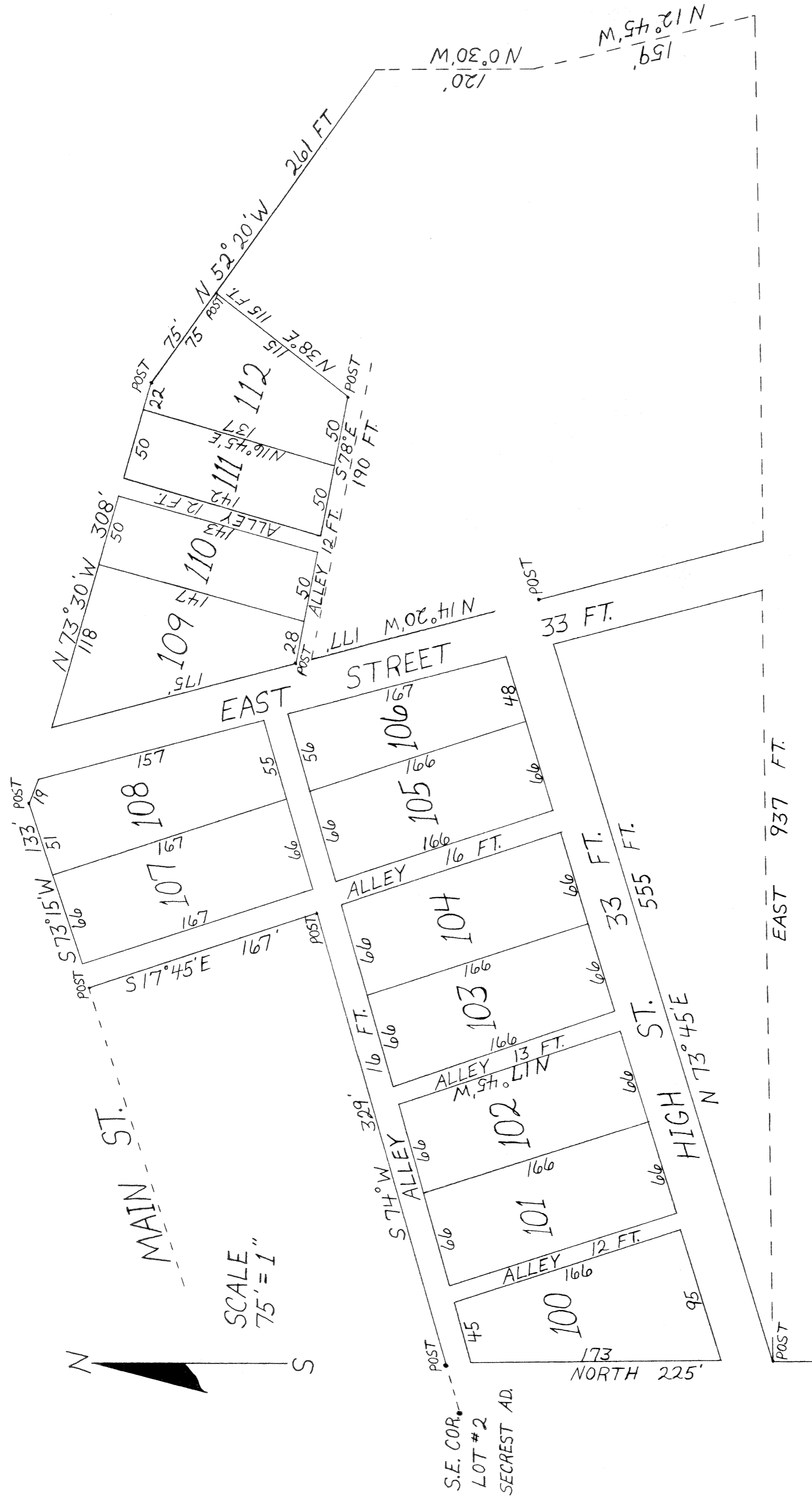

DESCRIPTION: SITUATED IN GUERNSEY COUNTY, OHIO IN THE NORTH WEST QUARTER OF SECTION NO. NINE (9) TOWNSHIP NO. EIGHT (8) AND RANGE NO. NINE (9) AND BOUNDED AS FOLLOWS: VIZ: BEGINNING AT A POST NORTH 74° EAST 36½ FEET FROM THE SOUTH EAST CORNER OF LOT NO. TWO (2) SECREST'S ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF POINT PLEASANT (NOW PLEASANT CITY): THENCE SOUTH TWO-HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE (225) FEET TO A POST; THENCE NORTH SEVENTY THREE DEGREES AND FORTY-FIVE MINUTES (73°45') EAST FIVE HUNDRED & FIFTY-FIVE (555) FEET TO A POST; THENCE NORTH FOURTEEN DEGREES AND TWENTY MINUTES (14°20') WEST ONE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN (177) FEET TO A POST; THENCE SOUTH SEVENTY-EIGHT DEGREES EAST ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN (115) FEET TO A POST; THENCE NORTH THIRTY-EIGHT DEGREES EAST ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN (115) FEET TO A POST; THENCE NORTH SEVENTY-TWO DEGREES AND TWENTY MINUTES WEST SEVENTY-FIVE FEET (75) TO A POST; THENCE SOUTH SEVENTY-THREE DEGREES AND THIRTY MINUTES WEST THREE HUNDRED AND EIGHT (308) FEET TO A POST; THENCE SOUTH SEVENTY-THREE DEGREES AND FIFTEEN MINUTES WEST ONE HUNDRED AND THIRTY THREE (133) FEET TO A POST; THENCE SOUTH SEVENTEEN DEGREES AND FORTY-FIVE MINUTES EAST ONE HUNDRED & SIXTY SEVEN (167) FEET TO A POST; THENCE SOUTH SEVENTY-FOUR DEGREES WEST THREE HUNDRED TWENTY-NINE (329) FEET TO PLACE OF BEGINNING. THE DIMENSIONS OF THE LOTS ARE MARKED ON THE PLAT, THOSE LOTS WEST OF EAST STREET, AS SHOWN ON THE MAP TAKE THE SAME BEARING, WHICH IS NORTH 17 DEGREES AND FORTY-FIVE MINUTES WEST THOSE LOTS ON THE EAST OF EAST STREET BEAR NORTH SIXTEEN DEGREES AND FORTY-FIVE MINUTES EAST.
