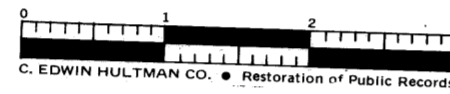


PLAT OF

I HEREBY CERTIFY THE ACCOMPANYING PLAT TO BE A TRUE REPRESENTATION OF A PLAT OF GROUND AS LAYED OUT AND PLATTED BY ME AS AN ADDITION TO BYESVILLE TO BE KNOWN AS TRENNER'S ADDITION. THE SAME BEING A PART OF MILITARY LOT NUMBER THIRTEEN (13) OF THE MILITARY LANDDISTRICT OF ZANESVILLE NOW A PART OF JACKSON TWP. GUERNSEY COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO. BEGINNING FOR THE SAME AT A STONE IN THE SOUTH WEST CORNER OF MILITARY LOT NUMBER THIRTEEN (13) RUNNING THENCE EAST ON THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID LOT THIRTEEN (13) SEVEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT AND FIVE TENTHS FEET (788.5). THENCE AT RIGHT ANGLE NORTH TWENTY-FIVE (25) FEET TO THE SOUTH WEST CORNER OF LOT NUMBER TWENTY-TWO (22) IN THE SAID TRENNER'S ADDITION. THENCE WITH THE LINES OF THE LOTS, STREETS AND AS SHOWN IN PLAT.

THE DISTANCES ARE GIVEN IN FEET AND DECIMALS AND ARE MARKED IN BLACK INK ON OR NEAR THE LINES OR SPACES TO WHICH THEY REFER. THE NUMBER OF EACH LOT IS MARKED ON ITS CORRESPONDING LOT IN GREEN INK.

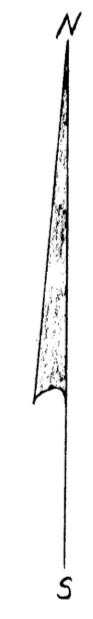
