
PLAT OF TEMPERANCE LINKHORN'S LAND

LINKHORN THE OWNERS OF THE LAND DELINEATED ON THIS PLAT DO HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE THE MAKING OF THE SAME TO THEIR ACT AND DEED AND WE DO HEREBY DEDICATE THE STREETS AND ALLEYS AS SHOWN THEREON TO PUBLIC USE FOREVER.
