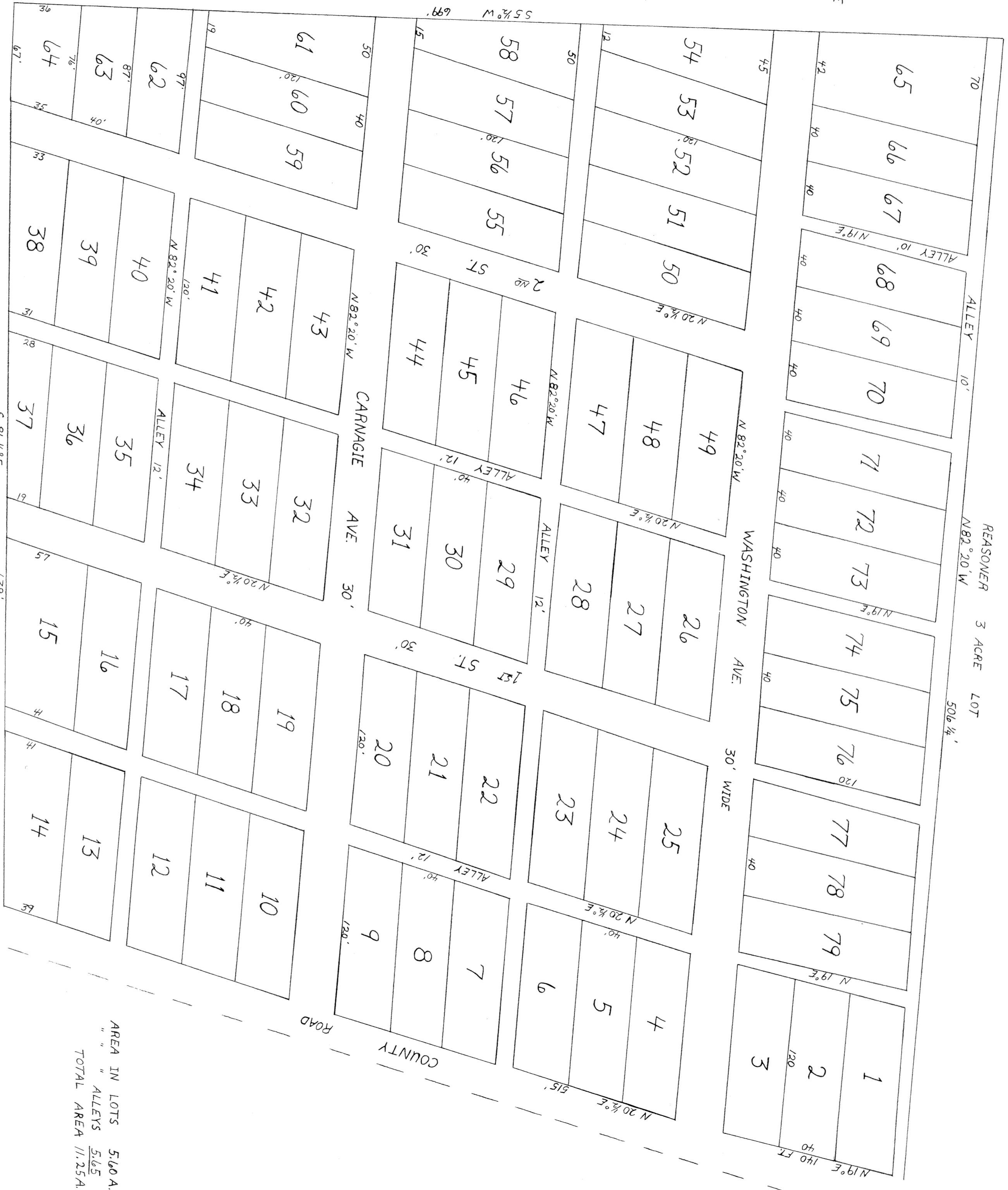


HOMER WITTEN'S ADDITION TO BYESVILLE

I CERTIFY THE ABOVE TO BE A CORRECT PLAT OF HOMER WITTEN'S ADDITION TO TOWN OF BYESVILLE, GUERNSEY COUNTY OHIO AS SURVEYED BY ME IN MAY 1903 UNDER THE DIRECTION OF SAID HOMER WITTEN. THE LOTS BEING NUMBERED IN RED INK FROM 1 TO 79 INCLUSIVE AND THE LAND EMBRACED THEREIN CONSISTS OF A PART OF THE NORTH HALF OF THE SOUTH EAST QUARTER OF SECTION 11 TP. 1 OF RANGE 3 AND CONTAINS IN LOTS, STREETS AND ALLEYS 11.25 ACRES, BEING THOSE PREMISES DESCRIBED IN THE DEED FROM K.S. REASONER AND WIFE TO HOMER WITTEN DATED THE 5 DAY OF MARCH, 1902 AND DULY RECORDED ALL LOTS IN SAID PLAT ARE OF THE DIMENSIONS OF FORTY BY ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY FEET EXCEPT WHERE OTHERWISE EXPRESSED BY FIGURES THEREON. STREETS AND ALLEYS RESPECTIVELY ARE OF THE WIDTH EXPRESSED IN FIGURES THEREON COURSES AND DISTANCES ARE EXPRESSED UPON SAID PLAT WHICH I CERTIFY TO BE PRECISE AND CORRECT ACCORDING TO MY SURVEY THEREOF. THE STONE AT THE SOUTH EAST CORNER WAS SET BY SAID REASONER AND SAID WITTEN AS A CORNER OF SAID PLAT.
