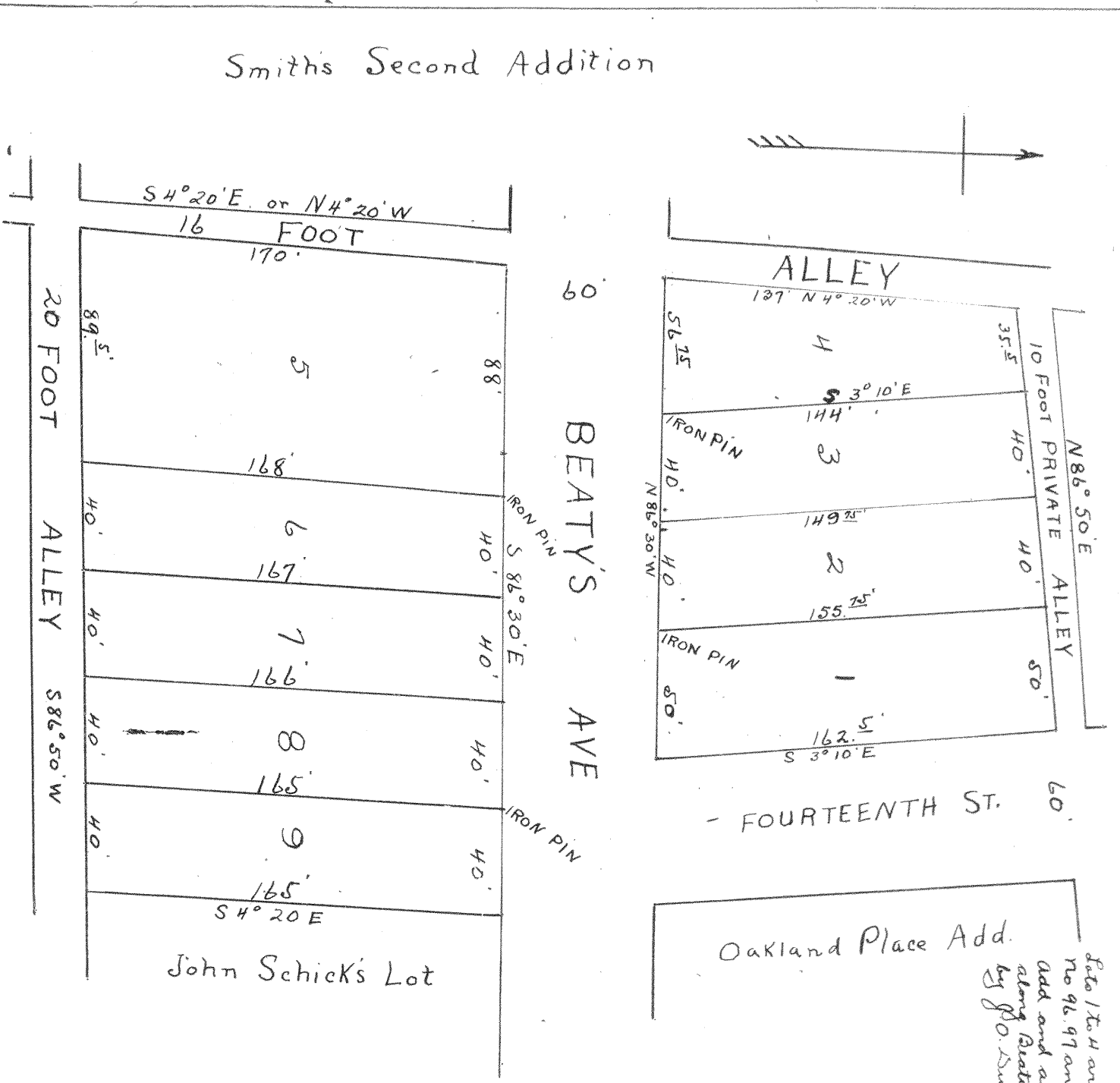


J. O. DUNIVER'S ADD.

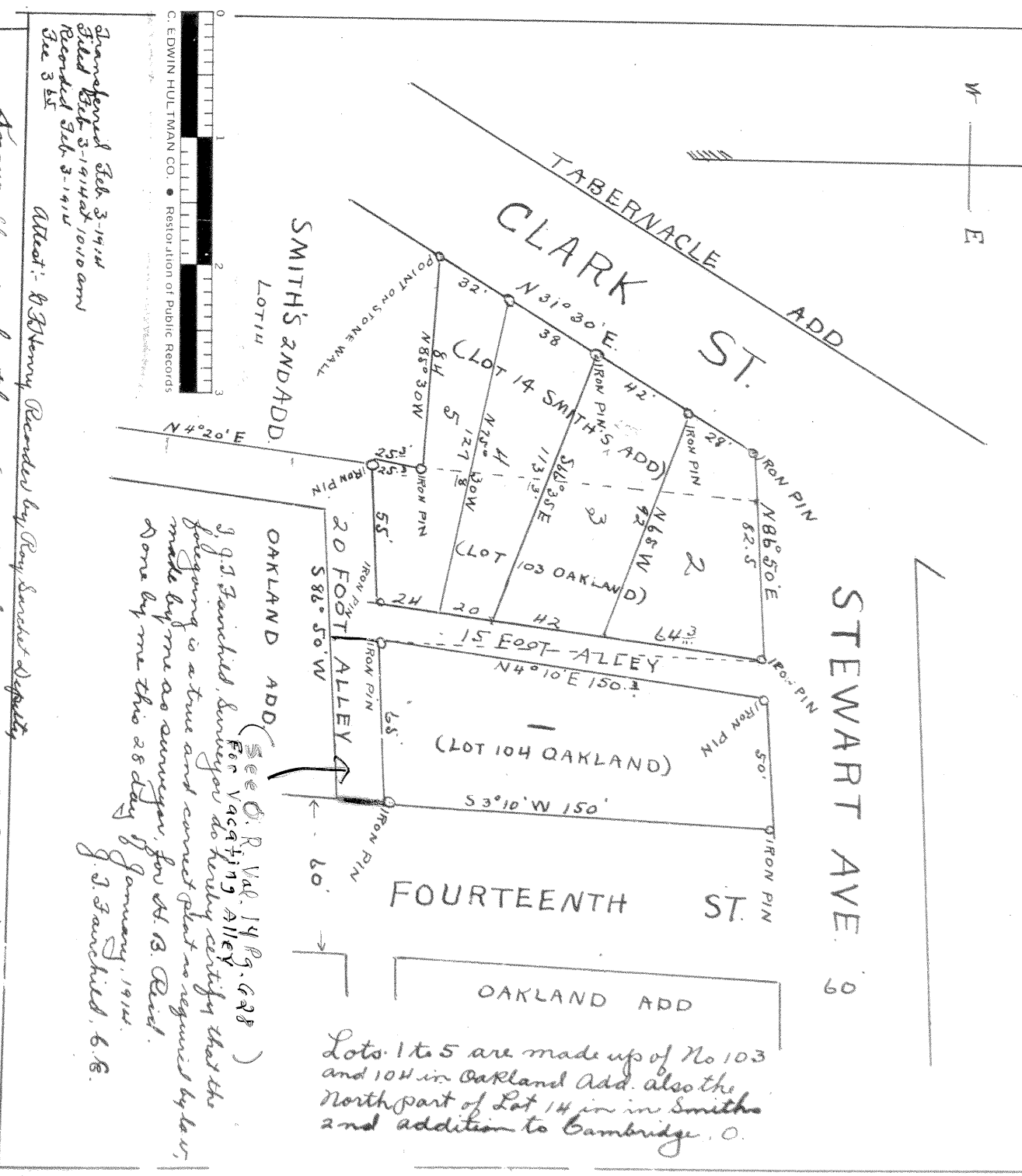
