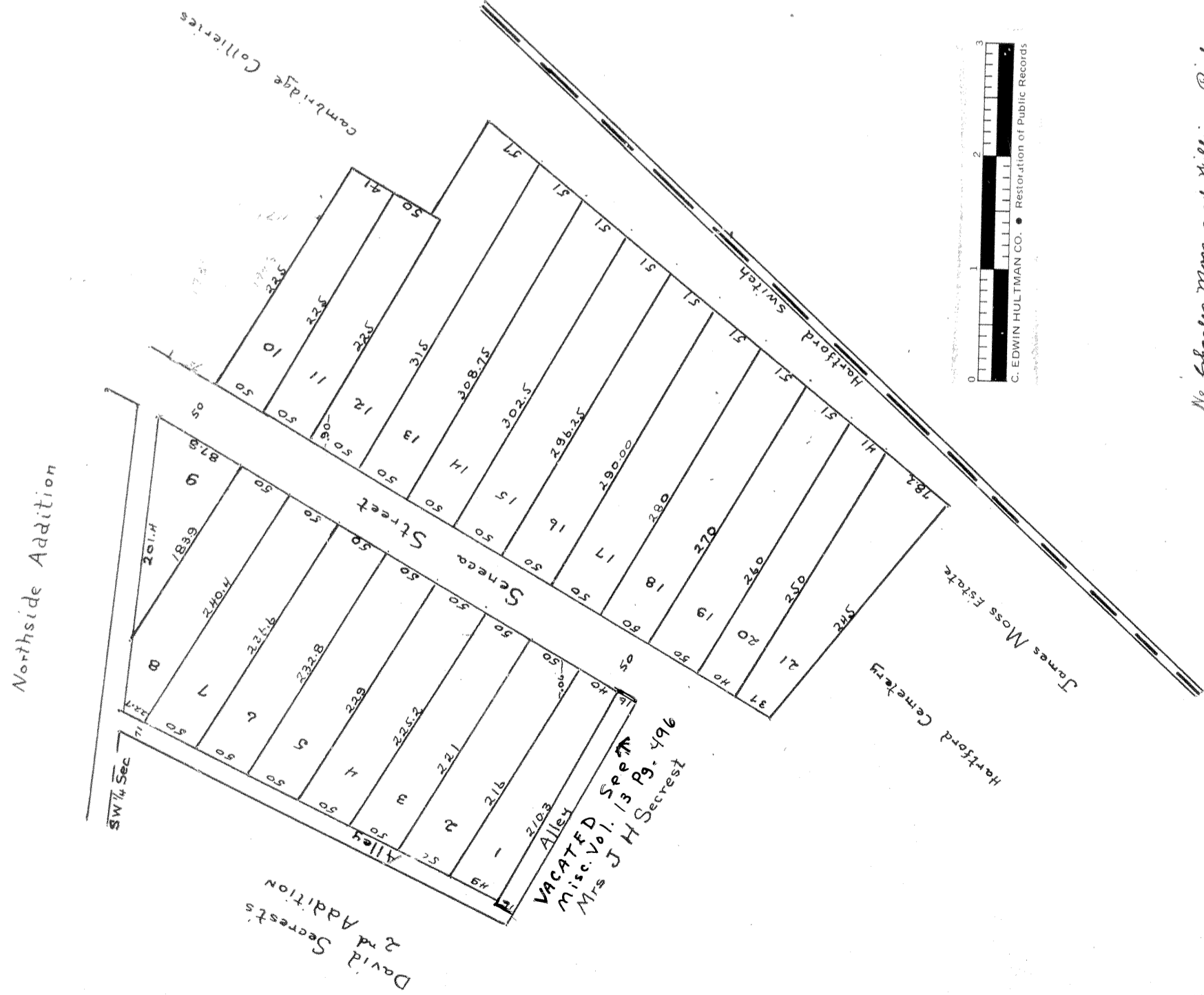


MOSS'S

Addition to Hartford



At the request of and under the direction of Charles Moss and William Rigny, Trustees and Executors of the last will and testament of James Moss, deceased, I surveyed the following described tract of land comprised within the accompanying plat of Moss Addition to the town of Hartford, Guernsey County, Ohio Township 8 Range 9 Beginning for the same at a point on the east side of the Seneca will where the 1/2 sec. line crosses said road thence along 1/4 Sec. line and Northside addition 17.85° W 325 feet thence by said Sec. line S 30° 30' W 385 feet thence by Mrs. J. H. Seestre S 80° 10' E 235 feet thence along Road S 31° W 110 feet thence by Hartford Cemetery on James Moss Estate S 51° 30' E 270 ft thence along Hartford thence South 17.42° 08' E 272 N 89° 45' E 261 N 60° 45' W 100 N 29° 50' E 84' N 88° 30' W 281' N 28° 50' E 50 to the City center my 5.80 acres in lots and 0.94 acre street + alleys.
