Note:— It will be noticed that the bearings as given on the Corporation line are not the same as the bearings on corresponding lines in the Oakland Place Addition. The reason is they are of different systems (i.e. were taken on entirely different surveys at different times and by different Engineers) The bearings on the Corporation line correspond to the system of bearings used in the survey of the City Park and the 510th St road leading to Northwood Cemetery.
