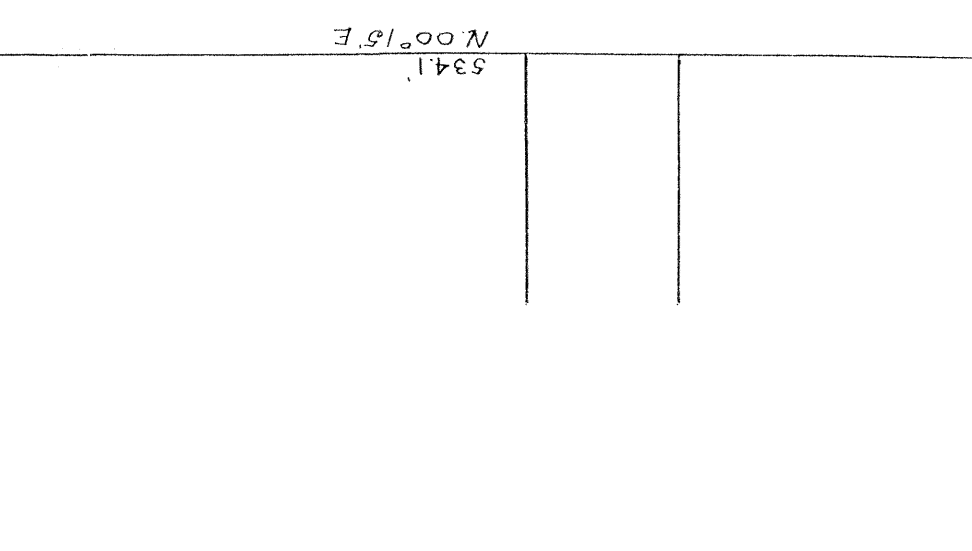

Description.
Being a part of the S W Quarter of Sec. 13 Range 3 Top 2 Rurveny County, State of Ohio commencing for the same at a corner stone A, said corner stone being located at the intersection of the center lines of the two county roads, one being termed 77.5th st, within the corporate limits of Cambridge, Ohio and Liberty road outside the corporate limits and leading to Northwood Cemetery the other being a county road running from said Liberty Road S89°43'E toward and intersecting a certain state road known within the corporate limits of Cambridge, Ohio as Clark St and without as the New Cornerstone Road, said road being termed Bagwood Ave. Thence S89°43'E, 1095.9 feet to a corner stone B, located at the intersection of the centerlines of the above described Edgeworth Ave and Taylor Boulevard, from the Taylor Boulevard N 00°43'W to Northwood Cemetery and thence S71°10'38'E, 97.10 feet to an iron pin B, located at the intersection of the center lines of the above described N 77°09'E and S70°38'E, 97.10 feet to an iron pin C, located at the intersection of the center line of the Taylor Boulevard and the center line of the Taylor Boulevard, said centerline of the Taylor Boulevard being at this time being a true circle curve having a radius of 99.8 feet and said circle terminating at G which is a tangent point, but for purpose of description will be described by its chords as follows: G to S, 2242.9348 feet; S to K, 2245.911 feet; K to an iron pin K on the circular center line of Taylor Boulevard, thence South 28°15'E, East 98.6 feet to an iron pin E on the circular center line of Taylor Boulevard, thence South 14°52' West 99.8 feet to an iron pin G on the circular center line of Taylor Boulevard, and being the tangent point of said circular curve. Thence following the center line of said Taylor Boulevard South 03°35' West 476.35 feet to a corner stone H, located at the intersection of the center lines of the Taylor Boulevard and 77.10th St. Thence following the center line of 77.10th St, South 81°00' West 534.10 feet to a corner pin D, located at the intersection of 77.10th St and Sherman Ave, thence following the center line of Sherman Ave, North 89°38' West 513.7 feet to an iron pin F, located at the intersection of the center lines of Sherman Ave and the West Taylor Boulevard, thence following the said center line of West Taylor Boulevard, West 26°35' East 213.9 feet to a corner stone K, on the center line of the West Taylor Boulevard thence North 00°15' East 533.5811 feet to an iron pin E on the center line of Midway Ave. Thence North 89°39' West 513.7 feet along the center line of Midway Ave to an iron pin M, on the center line of the aforesaid Liberty Road, thence following the center line of said Liberty Road, North 00°44' West 786.10 feet to the place of beginning A, and containing 29.489 acres more or less, and according to a plat and survey made by Prof. J. J. Bairchild, C.E., and Karl M. Coogrove, C.E., said plat being on record in the office of the Recorder of Rurveny County, Ohio, determination of meridian bearings as shown on said plat.

That said survey is a true and correct survey and all the courses and all the courses of the said tract of land as shown on the plat and survey made by the undersigned are correct and according to the survey made by them, that the part of the tract of land as shown on the plat and survey made by the undersigned is correct and according to their survey to the best of their knowledge and belief, and they further state that the courses set forth in the description and on the plat are the courses and all the courses of the tract of land conveyed by the heirs of J.D. Taylor deceased to the City of Cambridge, Ohio.
