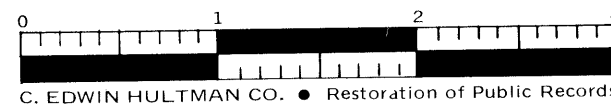
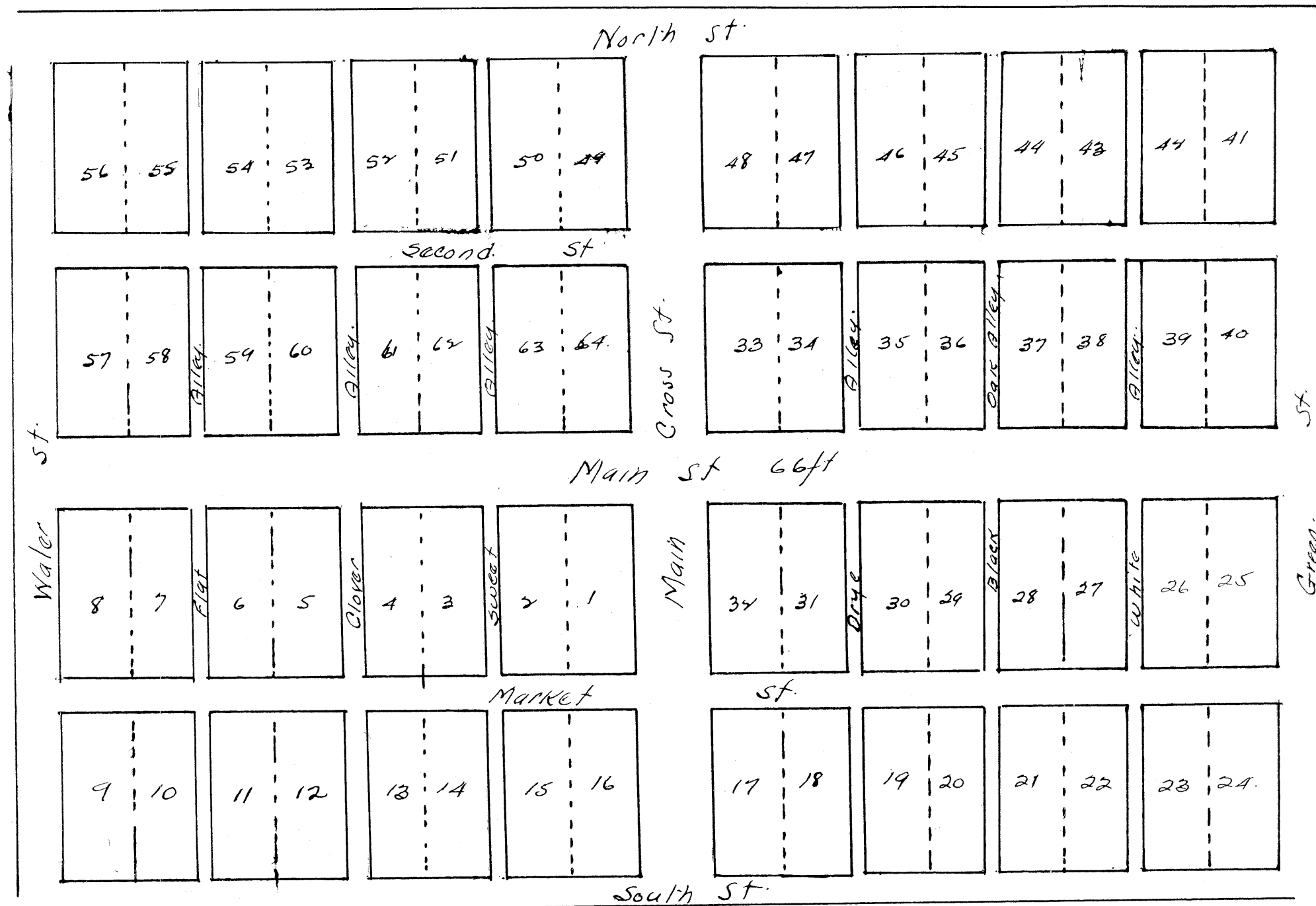


UNION TOWN
