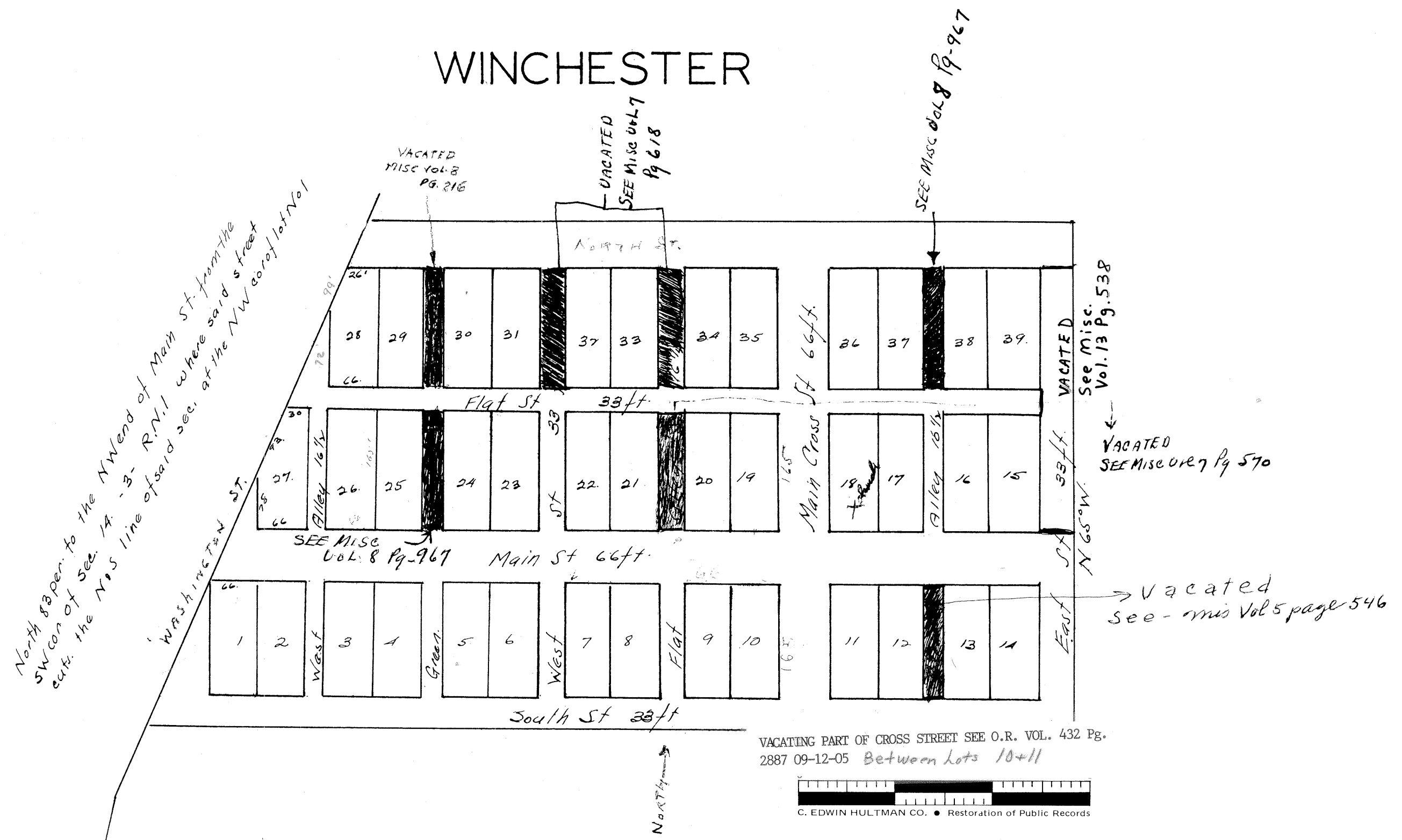


WINCHESTER



A description of the town of Winchester, situated in Sec. N 14 Twp. 3, R. 7, Zanesville district Gue. Co. Ohio with explanatory notes to said town. Main St 66 ft. or 4 per wide Runs N. 65° E. North Street running Parallel with Main St 66 ft wide. Flat St & South St also parallel with Main St. 33 ft wide Main Cross St. crosses Main St. at right angles. is 66 ft. wide East St & West St. N 65° W or parallel with cross St. & each 33 ft wide All the alleys Clear alley, Flat alley, Green alley & west alley are 16 1/2 ft wide or 1 per. All the lots in said town are 66 ft in front & 165 ft deep to 4 per front by 10 per. back. except lots No 27 & 28 lot No 27 being 66 ft front to west cor of said lot thence N by W 65° to se line 78 ft thence North on section line 93 ft to the N.W. cor of said lot thence East with North St. to cor of lot No 29. 30 per. thence South along west alley to Main St. 165 ft lot No 28. 165 ft deep on the east side 66 ft in front thence North to se line 72 ft along said line 99 ft. thence East with N. St. 36 ft. to the NW cor of lot 29
