

SENECAVILLE



A plat of the town of Senecaville with explanatory notes: Senecaville is situated on the banks of Seneca Creek, in Richland Twp. Gue. Co. State of Ohio, beginning 20 rods South from the NW cor. of Sec. No 21 Twp 1. & R. 2. running thence along the east side of P. High St. on the north & South line between the Sec. No 21 & 22. Twp & R. aforesaid unto the southern extremity of said town, being 105 rods. there are 96 front & back lots in said town, containing each 1/4 of an acre 48 of said lots are situated in the N.W. Quarter of Sec. 21. Twp & R. aforesaid, also 48 are situated in the NW quar. of Sec. No 22. Twp & R. aforesaid, each lot is 4 rods (66ft) in front & 10 rods (165) ft deep There are two Sts, named High & Bridge Sts High St. is 4 rods (66ft) wide & runs due N. & S. on the west side of the aforesaid Sec. line Bridge St is 6 rods (99ft) wide & intersects High St. at right angles. 15 lots from the North end of said town there are 5 alleys, 2 of which run due North & South, between the front & back lots, & are 1 rod (16 1/2 ft) wide the other three cross the former at right angles, 5 slots apart or 20 rods. Bridge St accepted same width The Town lots, Streets, Alleys, & Public Grounds contain 32.88 Acres.
