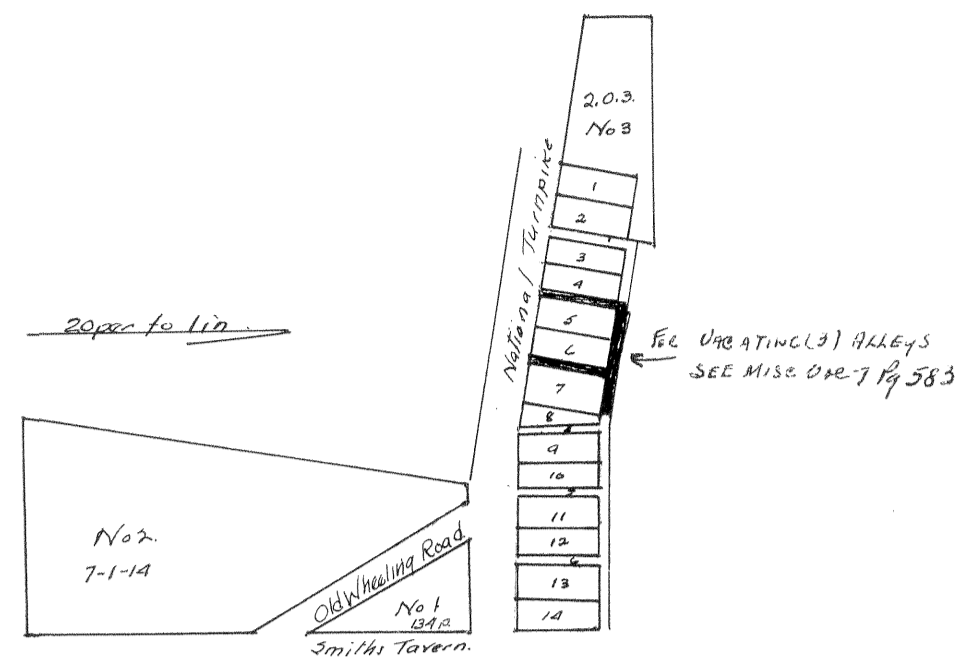
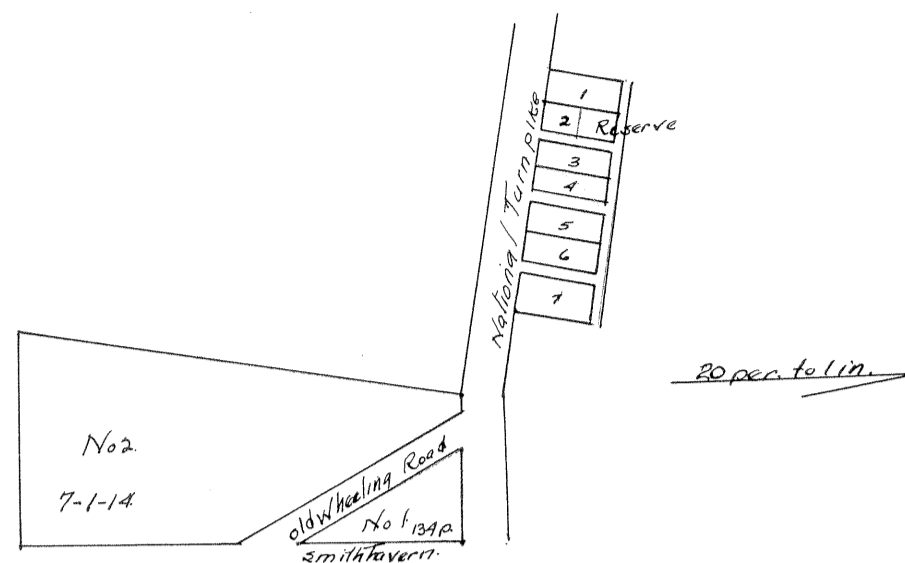


ELIZABETHTOWN

ADD. TO ELIZABETHTOWN



Plat of Elizabethtown laid out on the National Turnpike this 7th of Mar. A.D. 1832. prop. Jacob Weller. beginning at a stone north of said pike & west of Blacksmith shop, said Blacksmith shop stands in SE. cor. of half of lot No 2 bearing in front of pike is S79°E. distance 132ft. and 165ft back at right angles. including 1/4 lots. The back part or 1/4 of lot No 2 reserved. then commencing east of said shop on half lot bearing in front of said pike S80°E. distance each lot in succession 66ft in front & 165ft back. each alley 16 1/2 ft wide whole number of lots laid off north of Pike is 7. No. of alleys 3. National Road 4.8 rods wide. The above lots laid out south of pike commencing at a stone on the line between said Prop. & Smith. thence South. 22.04 per. the N 28 3/4° W 25.12 per. thence east. 12.16 per to the beginning contains 134 per. lot No 2 beginning at a stone west of the old Wheeling road & adjacent to pike thence S 27 1/2° E. 34.6 per. thence south 27.8 per. Thence W 28 per. thence N 8 3/4° E. 59 per. thence 2.80 per to beginning contains 7 acres 1 rod. 14 per. The back part or 1/4 of lot No 2 reserved thence commencing East of said shop on 1/4 lot bearing on part of said pike S 80 1/4° E each lot in succession. 66ft in front & 165ft back. each alley 16 1/2 ft wide whole number of lots laid off is 7. No. of alleys 3. National Road 4.8 rods wide back alley. 20 ft wide The above laid out south of turnpike commencing at a stone between said Prop. & Smith. thence S. 22.04 per. thence N 28 3/4° W. 25 per. = 12 hundredths.
