


N.B. THESE OUTLOTS TOGETHER WITH THE LOT #8 WHEREON IS THE STABLE, CONTAINS NINETEEN ACRES AND 86.3 PERCHES OF LAND AND THE IN LOTS AND FRACTIONAL ONES TOGETHER WITH THE STREETS AND ALLEYS THROUGH AND ADJOINING THE SAME CONTAINS 7 ACRES AND 22 PERCHES. THE QUANTITY OF LAND IN BOTH ADDITIONS AMOUNT TO TWENTY SIX ACRES AND 108.3 PERCHES.

LOT NO. 8 ADJOINING OUTLOT NO. 4 WHEREON IS A STABLE BEGINS AT A STAKE, FIGURE 1 IN SAID LOT FROM THENCE E. 7.5 PERCHES TO A STAKE AT FIG. 2 IN SAID LOT AND THE SAME STAKE AS FIG. 2 IN THE ABOVE LOT NO. 4 AND S. 6 PERCHES TO A STAKE AT FIG. 3 IN SAID LOT AND W. 7.5 PERCHES TO A STAKE AT FIG. 4 IN SAID LOT AND NORTH 6 PERCHES TO THE BEGINNING. CONTAINS 45 PERCHES OF LAND. LOTS NO. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 CONTAINS EACH 24 PERCHES OF LAND BEING 4 IN FRONT BY 6 PERCHES BACK. LOTS NO. 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, and 18 CONTAINS EACH 32 PER. OF LAND 4 IN FRONT BY 8 PER. BACK. FRACTIONAL LOTS NO. 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, AND 27 THE NUMBER OF PERCHES EACH CONTAINS IS SET DOWN IN THE SAME SUCCESSIVELY. THE LINE WHICH FORMS ANGLES ON THE EAST END OF SAID FRACTIONALS BEGINNING AT THE N.E. CORNER OF LOT NO. 19 BEARS S 15° E 37.5 POLES DISTANCE.


N.B. A STREET OF TWO PERCHES WIDE IS ALLOWED BY THE PROPRIETOR BETWEEN THE S.E. END OF SENECAVILLE AND THIS ADDITION OF IN LOTS NOW MADE TO THE SAME TO EXTEND EAST AND WEST BETWEEN THE SAME.

GIVEN UNDER MY HAND AND SEAL THIS 12TH DAY OF DEC. A.D. 1836.
