\* ORDINANCE No. 1801 -A  
 To except the plat of W.H. Taylor addition to the City of Cambridge Ohio. Whereas said plat includes the lands belonging to W.H. Taylor, from Wall Ave on the south, Brooks Ave on the north and from Fifth St on the west to Taylor Blvd on the east and whereas said plat has been duly plotted and acknowledged by the owner W.H. Taylor on the 14th day of Jan, 1926.  
 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF CAMBRIDGE OHIO,  
 Sec. 1. That the plat of W.H. Taylor addition to the City of Cambridge, O be and the same is hereby accepted and that the streets & alleys thereof be dedicated to the public use.  
 Sec. 2. That the lots therein so numbered on said plat be duly acknowledged and recorded as such addition according to law.  
 Sec. 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
