

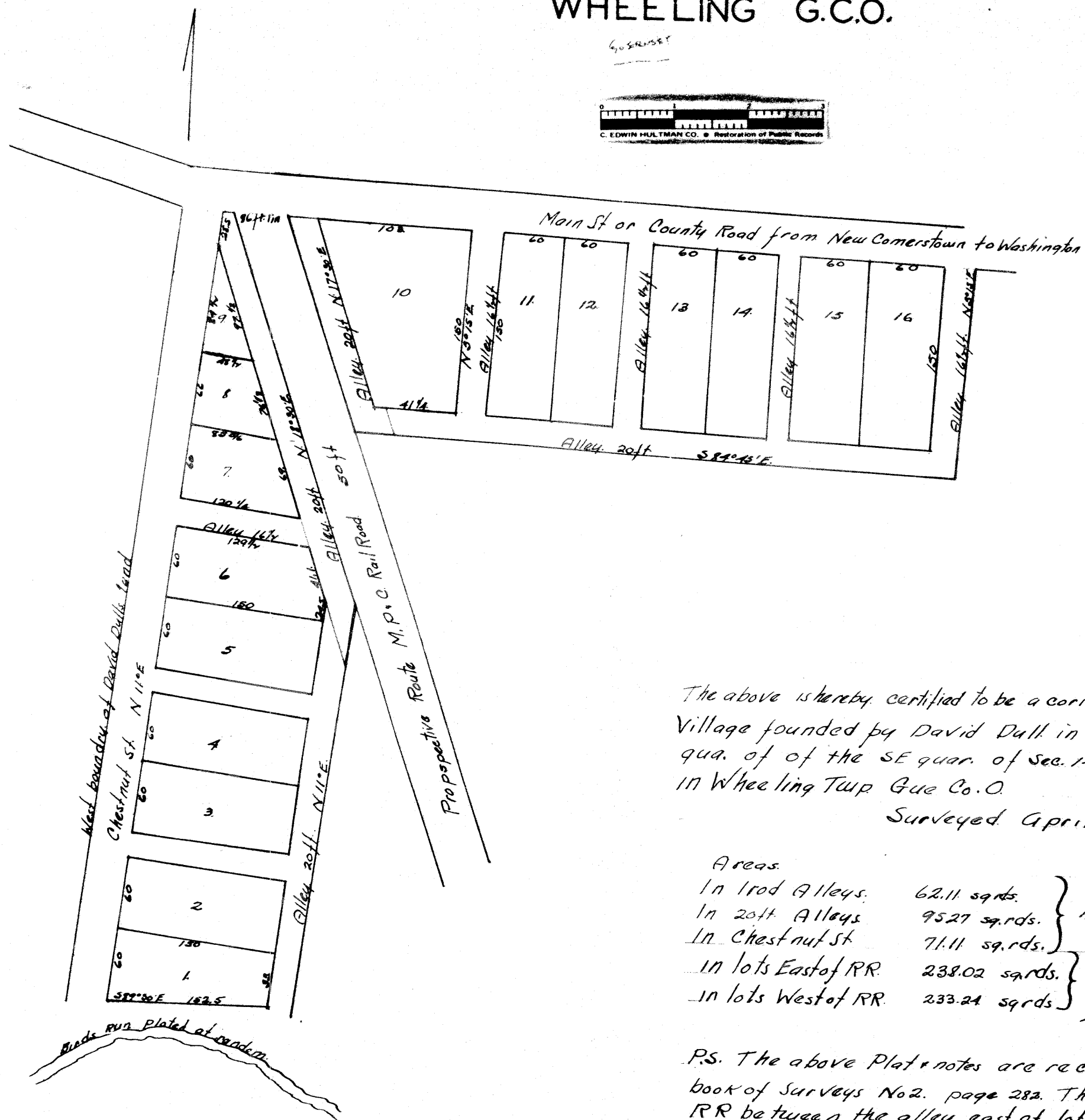

The space left for the RR between the alley east of lot No 9. and the Alley west of lot No 10 is more than 50ft wide a slight curve in the RR is likely to commence between those Alleys. distance from N.W. cor. of lot No 10 westward to intersection of N front with west front is 86ft + 1in. from said intersection southward to North point of lot No 9. is 28ft + 5in.
