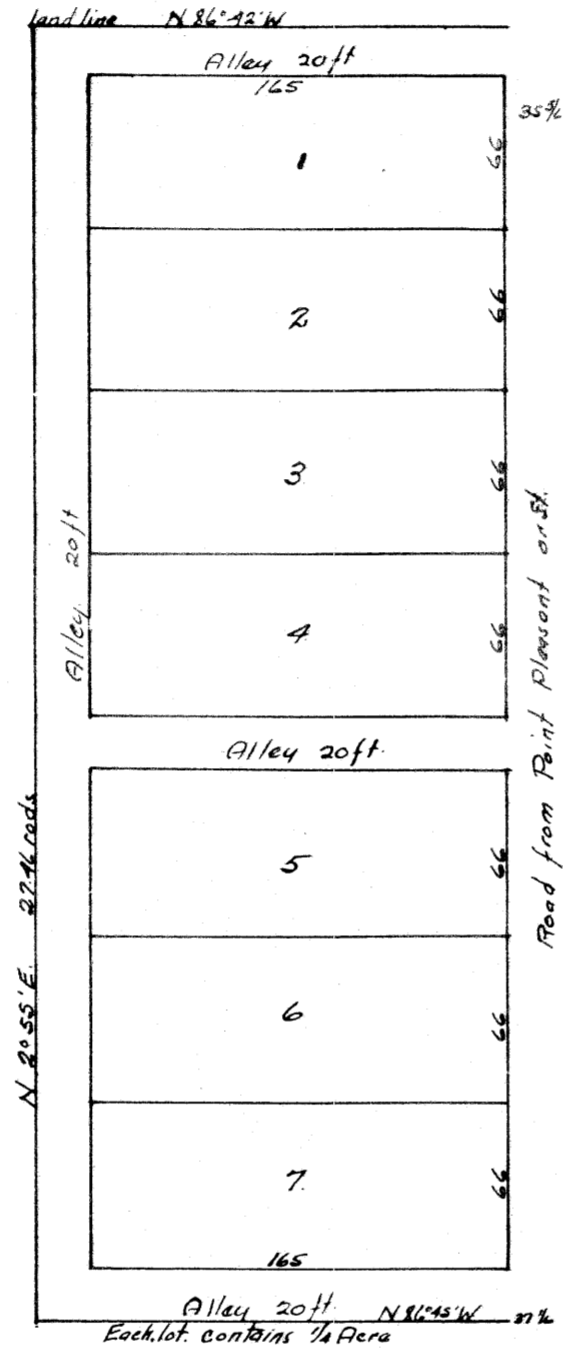
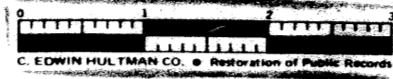


MEEKS ADDITION TO BYESVILLE

Said addition is situated in the N.E. part of Military lot No. 1. in the 3rd quarter of Twp 1 of Range 3. Jackson Twp Gue Co Ohio & contains in lots Alleys & Streets 2.64 acres.
