

A Plat or Map of the town of Guernsey, situated in the Township of Cambridge, County of Guernsey, State of Ohio - in the fourth quarter of the second Township & third Range of U.S. Military lands, as laid out by John Fordyce, & J.W. Robbins, & Madison D. Robbins proprietors on the 7th day of Nov. A.D. 1872. - caused by them to be surveyed by James Cosgrove a surveyor of said county, and this Map or plat thereof to be made by him. Particularly describing & setting forth all the Streets, Alleys, lots or fractional lots, within said town, describing the same by courses, boundaries, & extent, & numbering said lots progressively, from No 1 to 20 inclusive. Railroad St runs parallel with the Baltimore & Ohio Rail Road Central Ohio Division 16ft wide, soff distance from Centerline of said road. Water St is 20ft wide. Stones are planted at the corners of lot No 1, indicated on the plat from which to make future surveys. Nov 7th 1872.
