

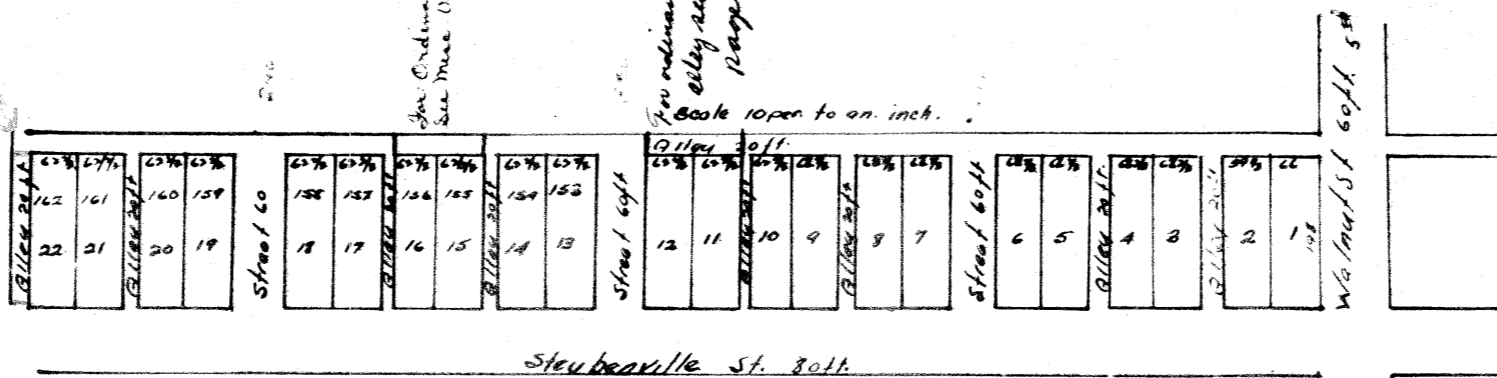
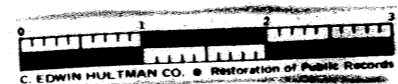

Jan. 5th 1866 Surveyed the above Addition to the town of Cambridge Commencing at a Black Locust Tree for a corner at point on the west side of Walnut St. of said town of Cambridge where continuation of the north line of Steubenville St. intersects the west side of Walnut St. Said point being the S.E. cor. of lot No 141 of this addition & thence running North 88 1/4° W 104.15 per. thence S 13 1/4° W 12 per. thence S 88 1/4° E 104.15 per. thence N 13 1/4° E 12 per to the place of beginning containing 7.81 Acres. Numbered 142 to 162 inclusive being 198 ft. in breadth. & said lots numbered 142 to 162 inclusive are 62 ft in width & said lot No 141 being 66 ft in width
