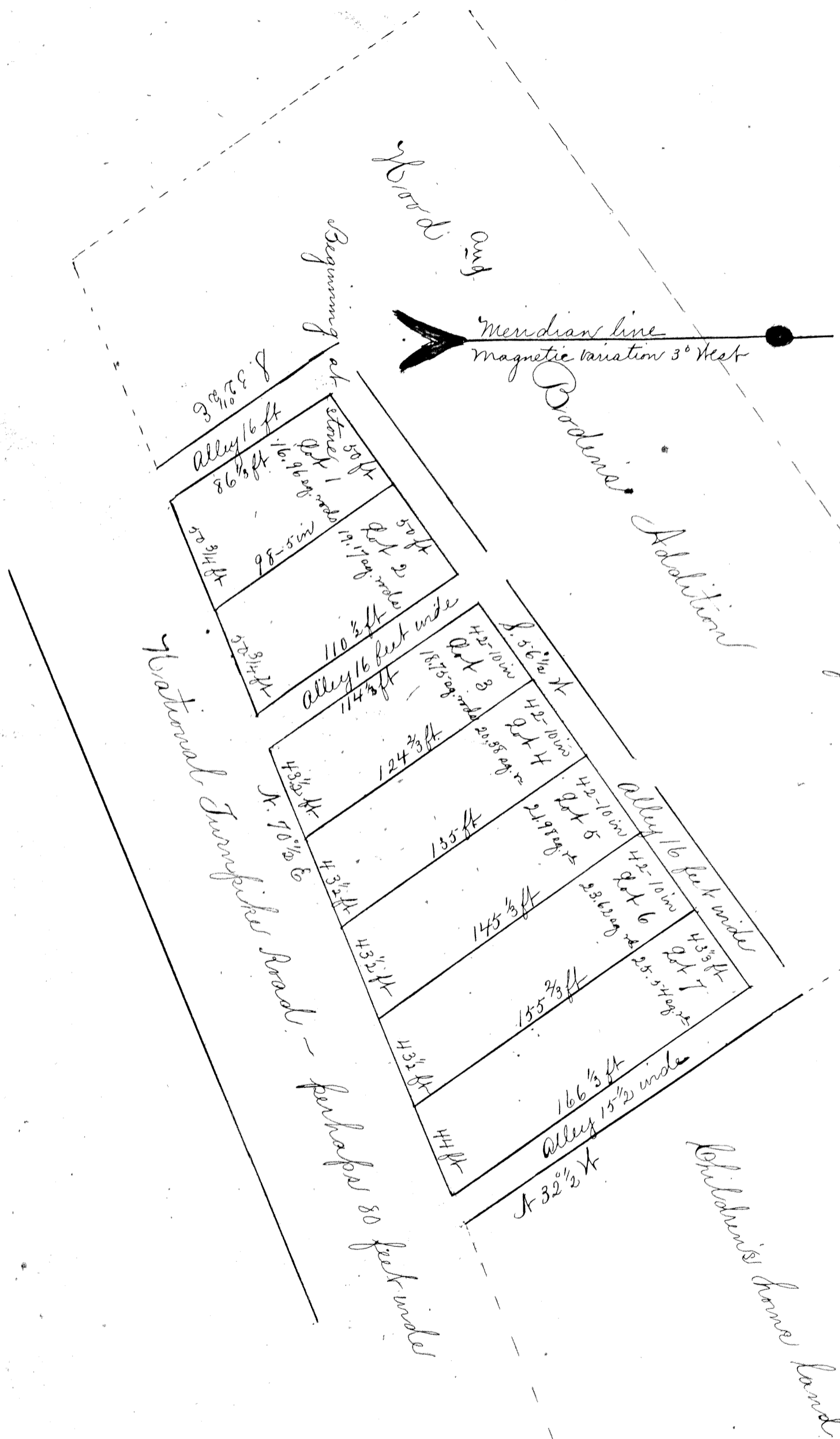


Plat of Smith's Addition to Cambridge, in Quenow County Ohio.
