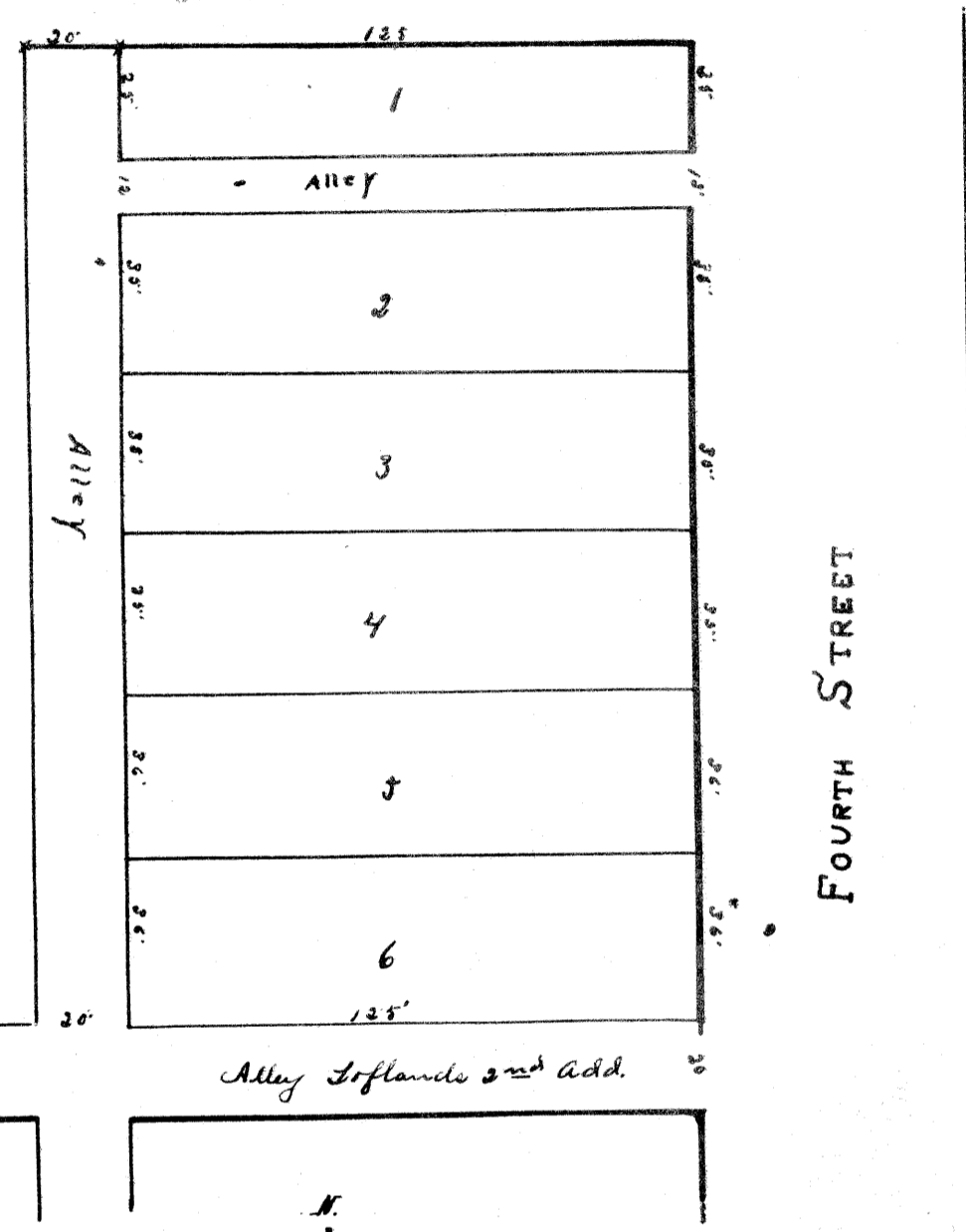
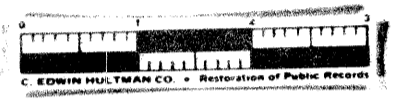


PLAT OF LEPAGE AND HARRIS ADDITION

SCALE 2 1/2" = 1 IN

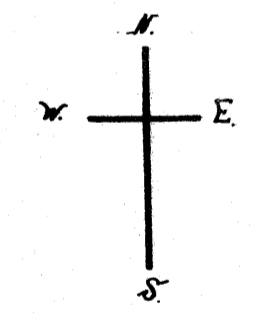
