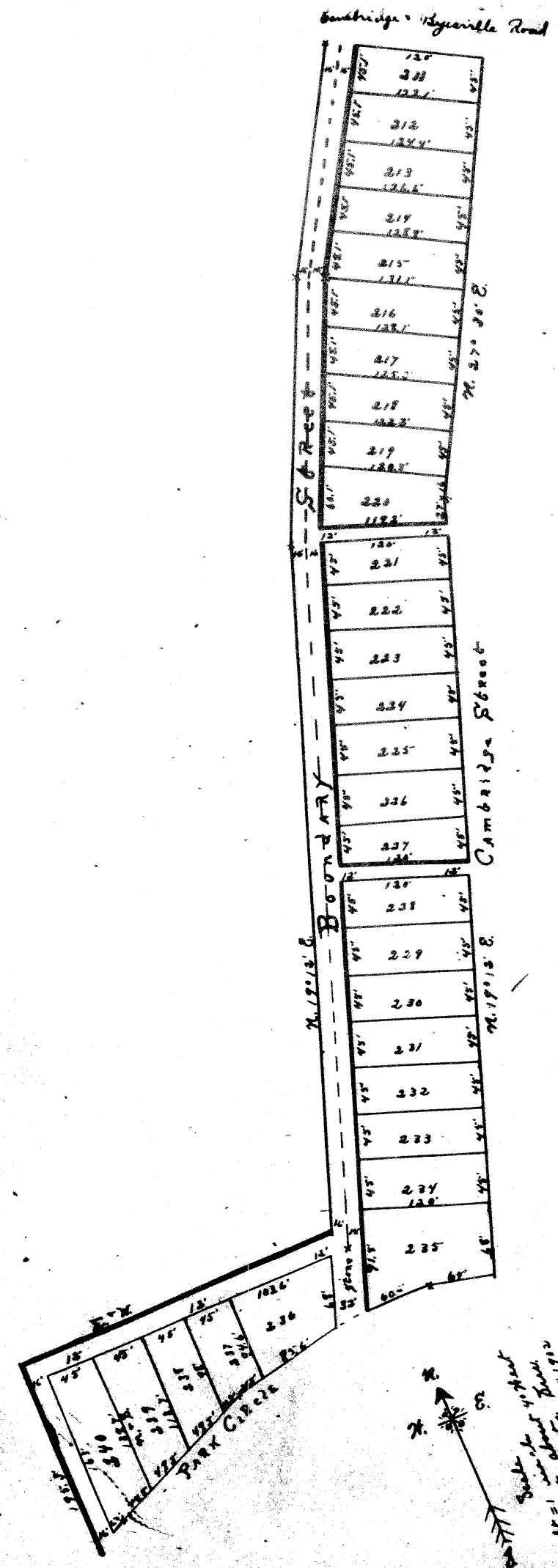
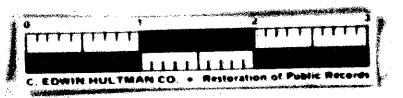

I hereby certify that by the direction of the Cambridge Improvement Company, proprietor of said premises, I made a survey and platting of Out-Lot 2 and the East part of Out-Lot 1 of the Improvement Company's Addition to Cambridge, Ohio, and that the accompanying plat is a true and correct representation of said survey, platting and subdivision. I further certify that the lots shown on the accompanying plat are numbered progressively from 211 to 240 as shown, and that said lots are respectively of the dimensions shown, as are also the streets and alleys thereon appearing. The State of Ohio, Lucas County, ss: Before the undersigned authority personally appeared the Cambridge Improvement Company, owners of the subdivision above platting, by R. V. Crane as its President and Fred L. Rosemond as its Secretary, and acknowledged the execution of the foregoing plat as a true plat of a subdivision of the eastern part of Out-Lot One and all of Out-Lot Two in the Improvement Company's Addition to Cambridge, consisting of lots consecutively from 211 to 240, both inclusive, and of alleys and highways as shown, said lots and thoroughfares being of the dimensions therein indicated by figures and fractions thereof said alley in the rear of lots numbered 236 to 240 inclusive and the west half of Boundary Street are laid out upon land formerly owned by John H. Sanderson deceased, and granted by his heirs for the purpose of such street and alley and further acknowledged that said thoroughfares are dedicated to the public for public travel. In testimony of such acknowledgment witness the name of said Company, by its President and Secretary and its corporate seal at Cambridge, Ohio, this 27th day of May, 1902.
