



Plat of Jacob F. Beereet's Second Addition to Pleasant City, Guernsey County, Ohio.



Description

The above addition is situated in the North half of the south west quarter of section eight (8) Township eight (8) Range nine (9), and bounded as described as follows: commencing at the north east corner of Jacob F. Beereet's first addition to Pleasant City, thence North 75° 20' East three hundred and sixty four (364) feet, thence North 19° West five hundred and forty six (546) feet, thence South 75° 20' West five hundred and thirty-four (334) feet, thence North 19° West one hundred and fifty (150) feet, thence South 75° 20' West five hundred and ten (510) feet, thence South three hundred and thirty-five (335) feet, thence North 75° 20' East three hundred and ninety-seven (397) feet, thence South 19° East three hundred and eighty-one (381) feet to place of beginning, and contains in the subdivision of the same into lots as shown in the annexed plat. The linear division of the lots the width of the streets and alleys appear on the plat in the denomination of feet and decimal thereof.
