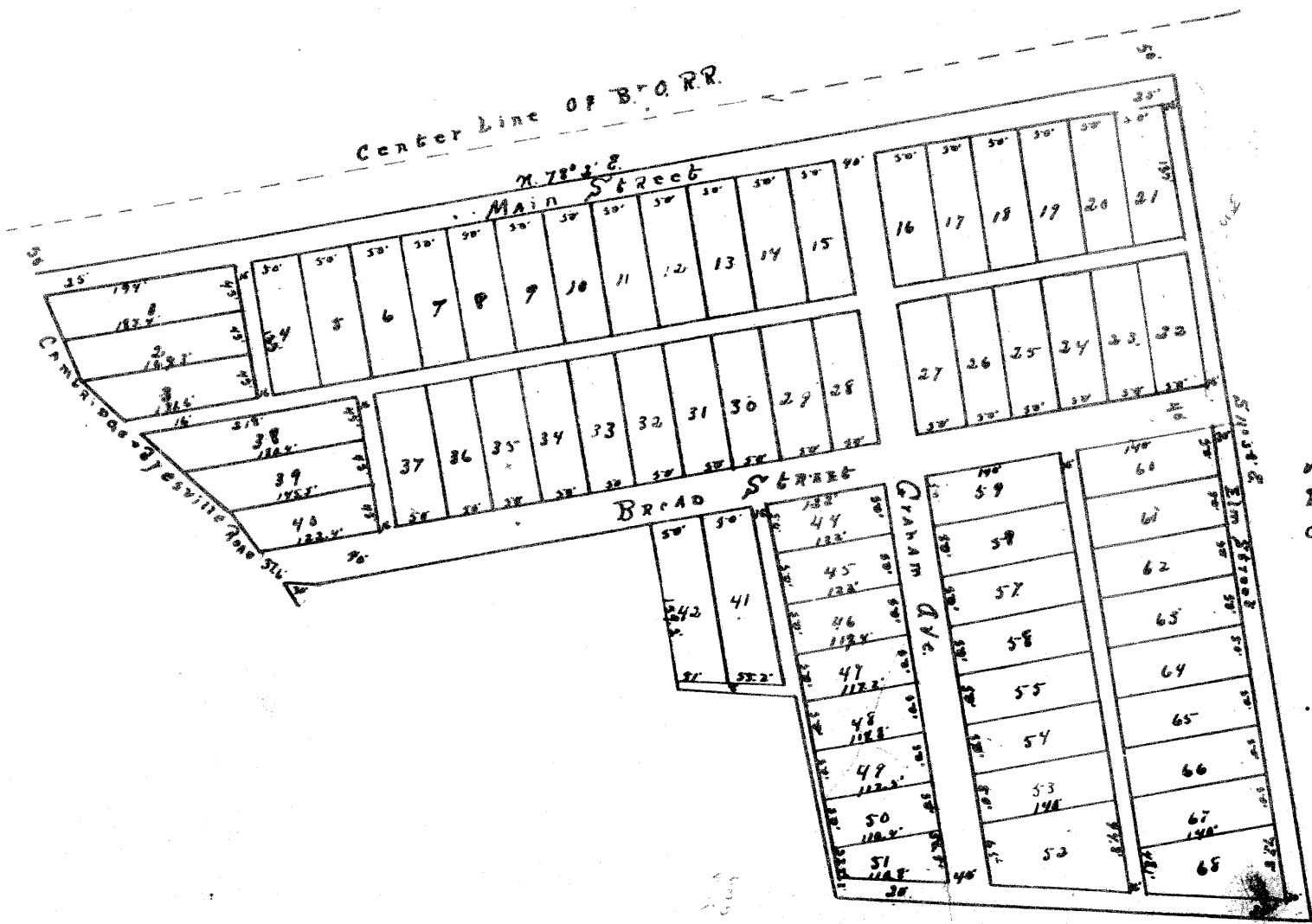
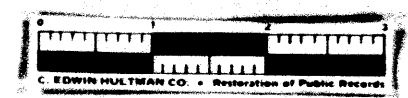


A. J. Kistler & H. H. Hixon's Addition to East Cambridge, Kennesaw County, Ohio.
