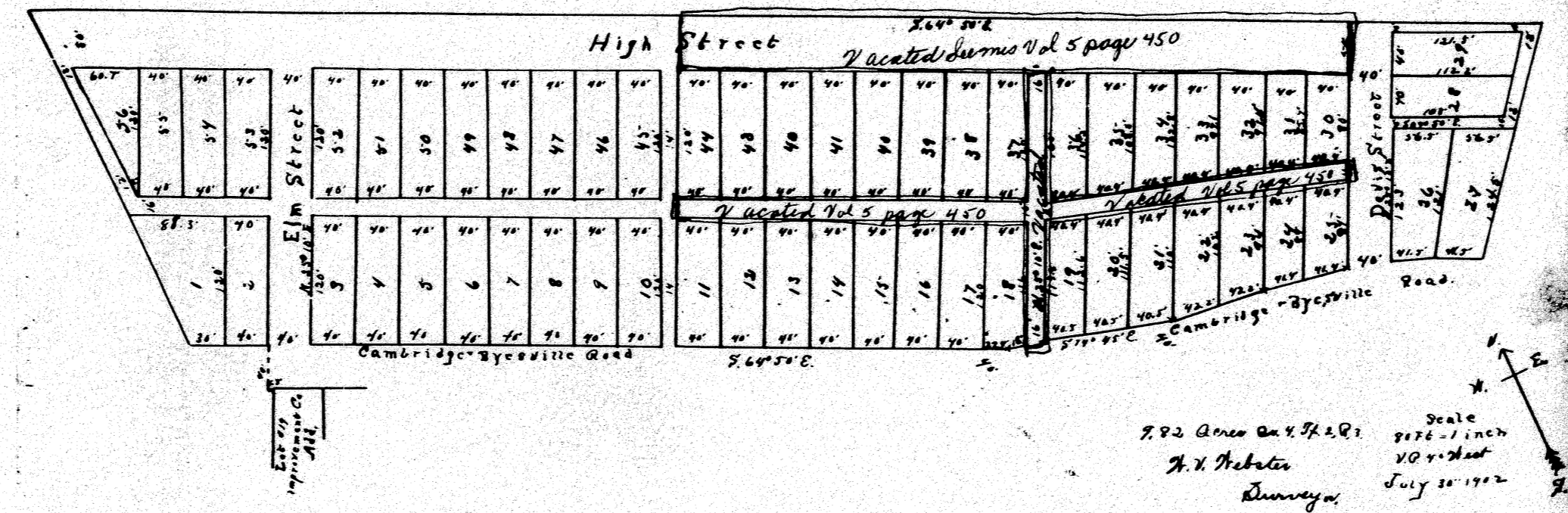
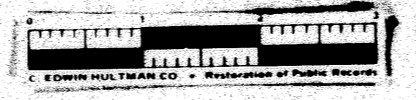


VESSELS ADDITION TO CAMBRIDGE OHIO
