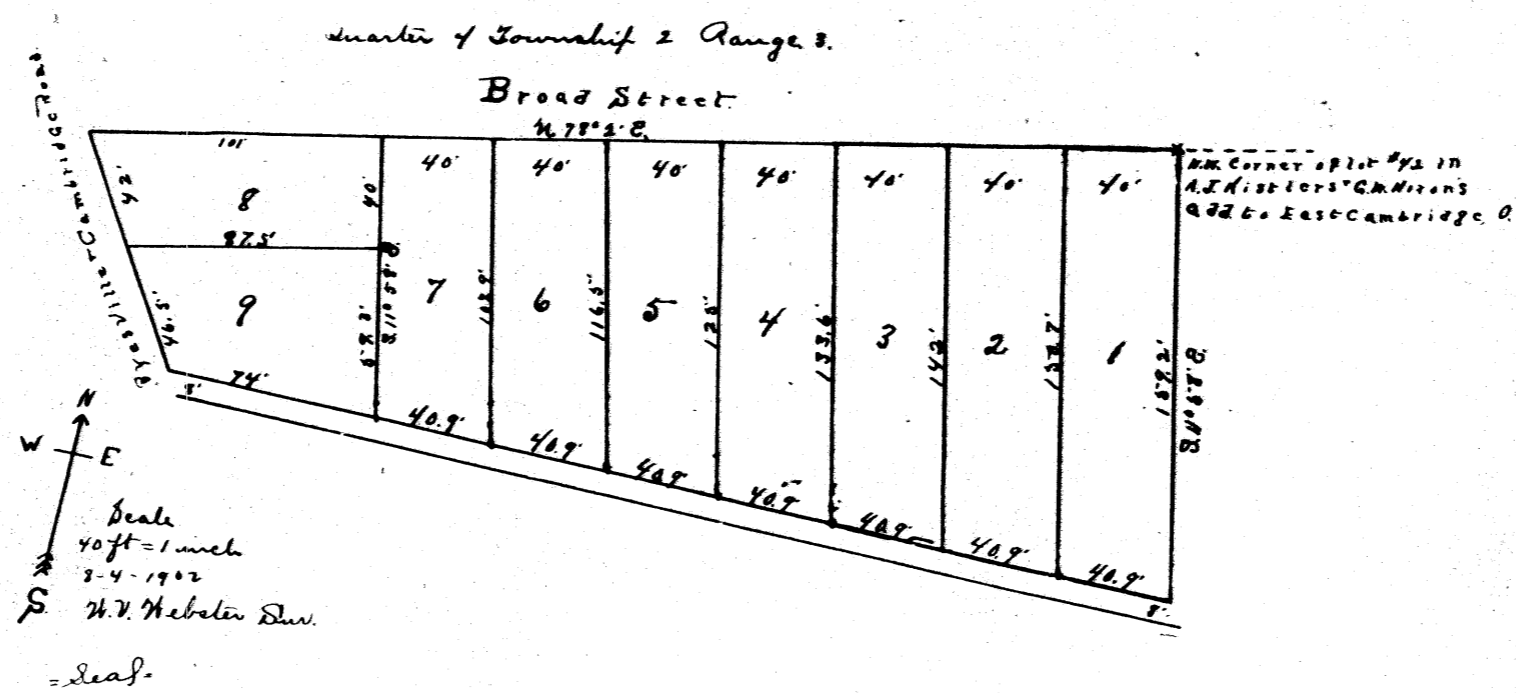
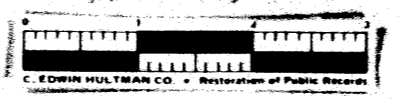


GEORGE W. TURNBAUGH'S ADDITION TO EAST CAMBRIDGE, OHIO
