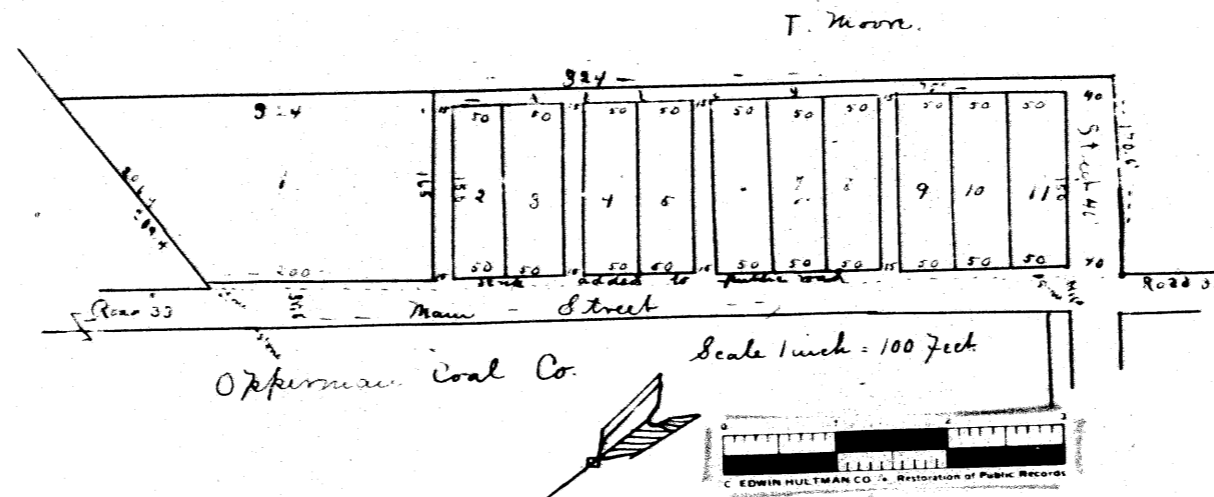


PLAT OF OPPERMAN
 Situated In

Description

The above tract embraces a part of the North East quarter of the South East quarter of the North East quarter of Section 14, Township Nine (9), Range Ten (10), and bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a stone on East side of road bearing North 90° West and distant five hundred and forty five (545) feet from stone at North East corner of said quarter. Thence South 57° 30' West along S.W. side of road Seven hundred ninety five and eight tenths (795.8) feet. Thence South 52° 36' East one hundred and seventy and six tenths feet (170.6). Thence North 57° 30' East nine hundred and twenty four (924) feet. Thence North 70° West two hundred and thirteen and four tenths feet (213.4) to place of beginning. Containing three and thirty seven hundredths (3.37) Acres. The linear divisions of the lots, the width of the streets and alleys appear on the plat in the denomination of feet and decimals thereof.
