Said Board of Commissioners further find that the limits of said proposed corporation are unreasonably large, and that the following described territory should be omitted from the same. Beginning at a point on the line between 1 degree and 30 minutes West, 765 feet from the South west corner of the territory, and in said petition, thence South 86 degrees and 30 minutes East, 740 feet; thence South 75 degrees and 30 minutes East, 397 feet; thence South 30 degrees West 210 feet to intersect the original line, and said Board of Commissioners hereby grant leave to amend the petition herein, by omitting from the territory described in the petition the territory as aforesaid described and set forth, and said petition is hereby amended by said omission.

And it further appearing to the said board that it is right and proper that said petition, as amended, should be granted, it is hereby ordered that the prayer of the said petition, as amended, be granted, and that the territory as described in the said petition, as amended, may be organized into a town, to be known as the Village of More City, as proposed for in said petition as amended, and that a certain transcript made by a majority of the Board of all the orders and proceedings of the Board relative to said petition as amended, and having thereon, together with said petition, and all other records and proceedings relating to said matter, be transmitted at once to the recorder of the County of Lucas, Ohio, as aforesaid.
