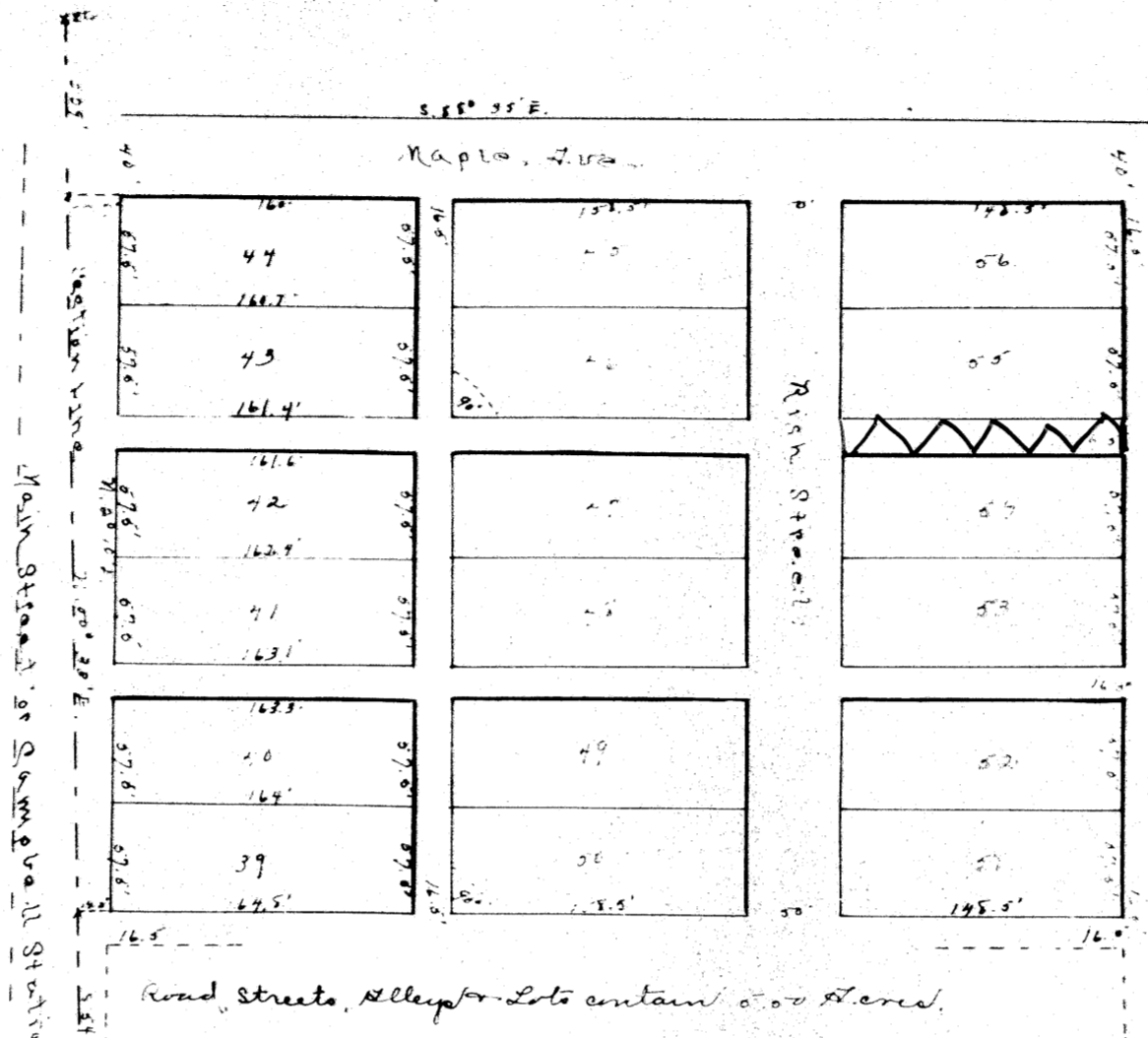


John M. Rich's Second Addition to Lincolnville, D. C. Oct. 23, 1901.
