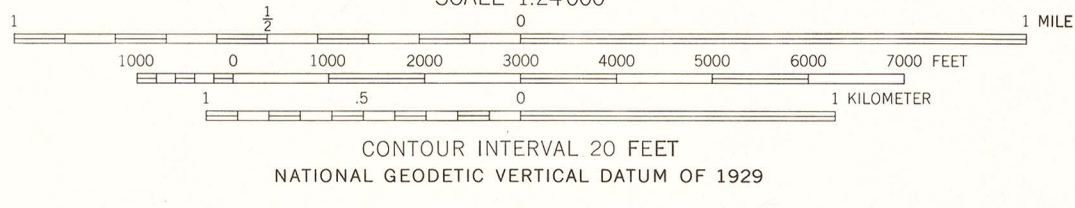
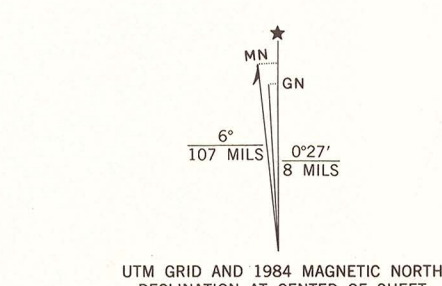

Polyconic projection, 10,000-foot grid ticks based on Ohio coordinate system, south zone
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17, shown in blue
1927 North American Datum
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 4 meters south and 13 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks
Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation to 779 feet
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked
Entire area lies within the United States Military District Land lines based on the Base Line of the United States Military District
